How to Use Key-Word Feature of News-Letter

In order to aid in catching the items that concern you and to facili-tate clipping and filing, a key word in small capitals has been printed on the right of the line above each article. The key words used fit into any system of classification, whether it be a straight alphabetical file, a system of your own devising, the Library of Congress classification or the Dewey system.

Note that you can clip out any article without fear of damaging another article in which you might be interested, since editorial matter printed on the righthand pages is backed by advertising, standing matter or a continuation of the article on the other side.

Library of Congress Classification

The classification of the Library of Congress has come into common use in the libraries of the country owing to the publication of the Government of the card index of all new books.
