

How to Use Index Word Feature

Agriculture. General.

In order to aid in catching the items that concern you and to facilitate clipping and filing, a key-word in italics is printed under the heading of each article. The key words used fit into any system of classification, whether it be a straight alphabetical file, a system of your own devising, the Library of Congress classification or the Dewey

Note that you can clip out any article without fear of damaging another original article in which you might be interested, since editorial matter printed on the right-hand pages is backed by advertising, standing matter, a continuation of the article on the other side, or reprinted quotations.

Library of Congress Classification

The classification of the Library of Congress has come into common use in the libraries of the country owing to the publication by the government of the card index of all new books.
