

# **ILLUSIONS AND DELUSIONS OF THE** SUPERNATURAL AND THE OCCULT

D. H. Rawcliffe, \$2.00

This is the first publication in America of the most comprehensive and most penetrating analysis of seemingly supernatural phenomena ever prepared. Written by a psychologist who has spent years investigating "psychic phenomena" of all sorts, it contains illuminating discussions and explanations of hundreds of beliefs and practices, ranging from voodoo, black magic, belief in vampire and demons to the ouija board, multiple personality, possession, ghosts, the Indian rope trick (which is possible) and other material.

The author carefully considers source material, and examines impartially, but strictly, eye-witness accounts and second-hand sources, experiments and observations, and shows the rationale of much that is sometimes considered supernatural or "beyond science." He spends more than 1.00 pages considering the psychological mechanisms involved in types of delusions and hallucinations, and throughout takes into account such factors as suggestion, mental dissociation, hysteria, and drugs which cause mental abberation.

Dr. Rawcliffe's book, which is recognized as the standard survey of its field, is wide in range, and his treatment throughout is thorough, fair, and reasonable. He offers one of the finest examinations of the evidence for ESP and PK adduced by Rhine and Soal, and provides a great deal of material on aspects of abnormal psychology not usually discussed in books for laymen: oniomania, zoerastry, hemothynia, xenoglossia, etc.

This book is indispensable for anyone who is interested in a scientific evaluation and explanation of the strange phenomena which sometimes occur or are claimed to occur. It will explain the factors which enable primitive claptrap to survive in our day, and will also show you many aspects of your own mind which you have probably not suspected. It is also one of the most interesting books in its area.


