





No mathematician of the 19th century has as much to say to readers today as has Henri Poincare (1854-1912). In answering questions such as these, Poincare proved to be an important thinker as well as a scientist, and an author whose writings profoundly

influenced human thought. He virtually laid down the scientist's creed, clearing the air of confusing terminology and empty philosophizing on the subject of science, its method and its meaning to all of us—a subject that is even more important today than it was when Poincare lived!

## First English translation of these

First English translation of these vital writings!

Three volumes of his philosophical writings were published during Poincare's lifetime. Now, at last, the various lectures and articles that were prostitunously published as the fourth—and final—translated for the very first time into English. These last thoughts continue and complete Poincare's lively commentaries on math and science; they are the actual summation and logical conclusion of the ideas with which he set the world of science on its ear at the turn of the century.

All the pieces are reprinted in full. Since many of them were originally lectures, the wording and construction are succinct and easy to follow, even if you have virtually no scientific training! But all of them sparkle with Poincare's well-known gift for to-the-point exposition and clarity.

#### Essential to any understanding of modern science!

All told, this new Dover book is a memorable collection, a must for everyone in the sciences or planning a scientific career. But its value doesn't end there. In this age of almost daily scientific revolution, we must all try to understand the philosophy of science and its reason for existing. No one is better able to explain these to us than Henri Poincare.
