NOVAS DEL MENSE IN INTERLINGUA

Biochimia. — Thalidomida se ha provate capace a assister le estableimento de homograffos cutanee in muses. Iste constatacion esseva facite per un gruppo de medicos in London qui reporta que le mentioneate pharmaco esseva experimentalmente superior a varie alteres testate in le curso de lor investigationes de mechanismos immuno-suppressive. Il pare assi que thalidomida — de tragic memoria a causa del malformations fetal causate per illo — es non necessariamente excludite de omne futur utilisation in le tractamento de patientes human. In plus, on ha speculate que le potentia immunosuppressor de thalidomida es possibilmente relationate con le facto que su ingestion pote — sub certe conditiones — esser sequite del nascentia de un infante melomelic. Un feto pote esser considerate como un homograffo. Durante un pregnantia normal, ille homograffo — per un mal comprehendite mechanismo immuno-suppressive — non es rejicite, sed il es etiam un facto que le disveloppamento de un feto malformato es frequentemente interrumpte per un expulsion prematur, i.e., per un mechanismo de rejection immunologic del homograffo. Il es-serea iste mechanismo que es supprimite per thalidomida.

Communications. — David Sarnoff, preside del consilio de directores del Corporation Radio de America, previde le uso constante de satellites de transmission de radio e television a portata global e functionante a trenta milles watt. Sed, diceva Sarnoff ante un Conferentia International Super le Establimiento de Pace Mundial per Medios Legislative, etiam le benefic consequencias del remotion de ille obstaculos esserea tremende. "Quando", ille continuava, "nos ha le possibilitate de comunicar instantaneamente con non importa qui e non importa ubi, nos va inaugurar un movimento dynamic cuje ultime impacto politic, social, e economic super le humanitate es hodie ancora incalculabile... Quando, per exemplo, un satellite russe pote diriger su radiodiffusion directemente a un ferma de Kansas e un satellite american directemente a un collectiva hungare, que va esser le reaction in le duo paises?..."

Cytologia. — Mitochondrios es micrissime structuras intracellular. Illos occurre in le cytoplasma sed nunquam in le nucleo cellular. Isto esseva un generalmente acceptate facto, usque recentemente un gruppo de recercatores al Universitate Johns Hopkins, laborante con un microscopio electronic, observava le presentia de mitochondrios in le nucleos de cellulas leucemic. Le signification del discoperta es paucu clar, sed il es certe que le phenomeno es pathologic. Un possibile explication es que le mitochondrios es trappate in le nucleo in le curso de un mitose morbide.

Neurochirurgia. — Es reportate ab Tokio que un gruppo de chirurgos japones ha successosemente executate operationes in le cerebro human post refrigerar ille organo a 6 C (i.e., a 43 F). Le avantages del cryochirurgia (i.e., del chirurgia a basse temperatura) include le facto que in illo le permisibile duration del intervention es grande mente prolongate. Neurochirurgos american ha legitte le reporto ab Tokio non sin scepticismo. Illes trova difficile creder que le circulation sanguinee del cerebro pote esser isolate si completamente ab le circulation systemic que talmente basse temperaturas in le prime remane sin adverse effectos in le secunde.

Radiobiologia. — In le curso de tres annos de experimentos con muses, Dr. A. G. Searle de Harwell (Anglaterra) ha constatare que le frequentia de mutations causate per irradiation con neutrones rapide ab un reactor atomic excede per un factor de vinti illo causate per radios gamma e per un factor de cinque illo causate per radios roentgen. Le experimentos es-eva conducite con irradiation perdurative a basse nivello de dosage. Le resultatos non pote esser usate, per extrapolation, in predicer le efecto de breve irradiationes a plus elevate nivello de dosage.
