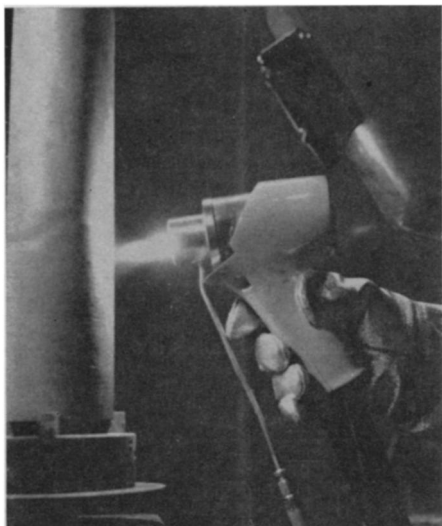

Most thermosetting plastics can be dispensed with this water-cooled plasma spray system, which is used primarily for insulating purposes. The plastic powder is melted by the plasma jet and applied wet to the desired surface, flat



or cylindrical. The fine spray hardens to form a dense, hole-free surface.
