

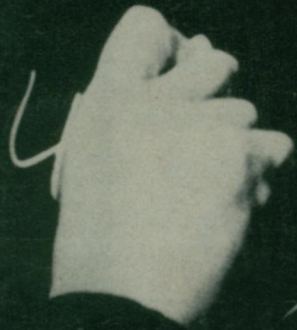

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CERN's human computer

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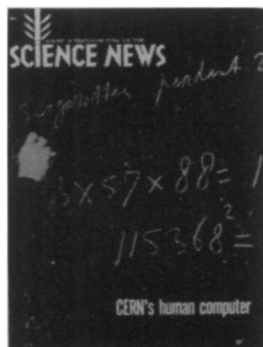

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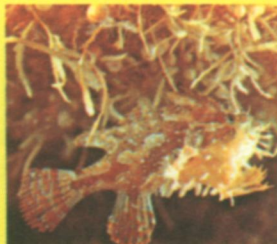
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Sargassum Fish duplicates look of seaweed, even to tassels and ribbons like air-filled bladders.
