ALFRED NOBEL: The Loneliest Millionaire—Michael Evlanoff and Marjorie Fluor, foreword by Simon Ramo—Ward Ritchie Press, 1969, 336 p., photographs, \$10. Presents the complex personality of Alfred Nobel, his family, work, patents, loves and enterprises.

THE ANATOMY OF PARAMECIUM AURELIA—A. Jurand and G. G. Selman—St. Martin's Press, 1969, 218 p., 54 plates, diagrams, \$18. Comprehensive account of the morphology of the organism, illustrating the ultrastructure with electron micrographs.

ATLANTIS: The Truth behind the Legend—A. G. Galanopoulos and Edward Bacon—Bobbs-Merrill, 1969, 216 p., color plates, photographs, maps, \$12.50. With the help of data from geological and archaeological research, the book explores the background to Plato's account of Atlantis, discounts its location in the Atlantic and establishes the probability of its location within the volcanic land mass of Santorin.

CATTLE AND KINSHIP AMONG THE GOGO: A Semi-pastoral Society of Central Tanzania—Peter Rigby—Cornell Univ. Press, 1969, 355 p., photographs, \$13.50. Study of the life and social structure of Bantu-speaking tribe in which cattle ownership symbolizes a complex network of personal relationships.

THE COMING OF THE GOLDEN AGE: A View of the End of Progress—Gunter S. Stent—Natural Hist. Press, 1969, 146 p., photographs, diagrams, \$4.95. Viewing the Golden Age as the last stage of history, the author first deals with the rise and fall of molecular genetics, then proceeds with arguments on the end of the arts and sciences.
