# TIMS OF THE WEEK

CARBON AND ITS COMPOUNDS. (3rd edition.) 16mm, color or b&w, sound, 16 min. Existing as diamond, the hardest substance, and as graphite, one of the softest, and in 90 percent of all known compounds, carbon is one of the most remarkable of elements. Basing carbon's uniqueness on its atomic structure, the film explores the world of carbon, from its bonding properties to carbon dating, using an atomic orbital model, diagrams, animation, structural and scale models. Explains the energy level of carbon's six electrons; hybridization; covalent bonding of carbon atoms; hydrocarbons, including of carbon atoms; hydrocarbons, including polymers, ring compounds and isomers; and the reactive group of organic compounds. Many aspects of carbon's properties which cannot be demonstrated in the classroom are shown. Audience: senior high, college. Purchase color \$200 or b&w \$100 from Coronet Films, Dept. SN, 65 E. GLACIERS. 16mm, color, sound, 14 min. Glaciers are rare now, but back 10,000 years and more in the Pleistocene, they were mighty and big. They covered most of Canada, a lot of northern United States and most of Europe. They still cover Greenland and Antarctica, for we are at the end of the last of several ice ages. During each ice age, so much of the earth's water was frozen that the oceans were 300 to 400 feet lower than they are today. That resulted in a "land bridge" from Asia to North America over which mankind migrated to the New World. Glaciers rearranged geography, and the ice ages at their height were terrible for the animal world. Audience: school, college, adult. Purchase \$165 from Northern Films, Dept. THREE FAMILIES IN DIFFERENT ENVIRONMENTS. 16mm, color, sound, 14¾4 min. This film looks at three families: the rainforest family lives directly off the land; the American farm family lives partially from the land, but also grows and sells crops to buy some of the things they need; the city family takes little or nothing directly from the land, depending completely on wages paid for specialized work. Each family ultimately depends on the land's resources for its food, clothing and shelter, but they differ in their relationship to the land. THE THREE R'S . . . AND SEX EDU-CATION. 16mm, b&w, sound, 60 min. Explores the many opposing responses which emerge when the subject is teaching sex education in the schools. For pupils attending Germantown Friends School in Pennsylvania, sex education helps them make moral and ethical decisions. Dr. Billy James Hargis, head of the Christian Crusade, believes sex education to be part of some larger satanic conspiracy exploited by Communists. The John Birch Society also campaigns against sex education. A bitter campaign against sex education in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is followed showing scenes of confrontation during PTA and school board meetings.
