Morphine test is a highly sensitive and economical drug screening process. This test will result in increased proficiency in drug testing in commercial labs, hospital labs, methadone treatment clinics and drug control programs. The test's most important characteristic is its sensitivity. It is capable of detecting morphine in urine at a level of 10 nanograms (.010ug) morphine per ml, which makes feasible the determination of the use of heroin by an addict as much as 72 to 96 hours following its injection. This sensitivity also tends to defeat attempts to foil detection by the intake of large volumes of liquid in an attempt to dilute the concentra-
