THE CHANGING FAMILY—Betty Yorburg—Columbia U Pr, 1973, 230 p., \$9; paper, \$2.95. Uses the findings of social science studies in an assessment of the changes in the behavior of young and old, and projects these trends in predictions about the future of the American family.

COMPUTER GLOSSARY FOR ENGINEERS AND SCIENTISTS—Wen M. Chow and Charles J. Sippl—Funk & W, 1973, 246 p., diagrams, \$6.95. A basic tool for beginners and a refresher reference source for those who need precise definitions of terms or explanations of specialized concepts in computer science.

CONSUMERS' GUIDE TO PRESCRIPTION PRICES: A Money-Saving Guide—William Gulick—Consumer Age Pr, 1973, 300 p., \$3.95. Designed to give the purchaser of prescription drugs a ready key to looking up the average retail price of any drug.

TEACHING SCIENCE WITH SOIL: An Interdisciplinary Approach to Environmental Education from the Points of View of Science, Mathematics and Social Studies—Albert Schatz, introd. by Jean Oak Kriebs—Rodale Pr Inc, 1973, 132 p., illus., paper, \$3.50. Suggests activities and simple experiments to provide a better understanding of the soil as an ecosystem.

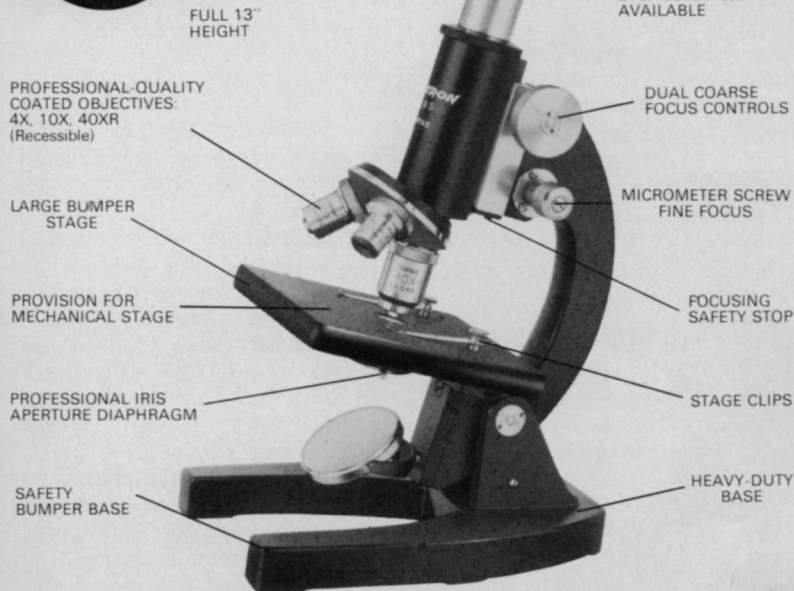
