The springs provide an oasis of water and greenery which attracts wildlife from all over the park. The film is concerned with the lives and interdependence of animals in and around the springs. Every animal living in the oasis provides food directly or indirectly for other animals living there, and in turn survives because of the success of other species in that environment.
