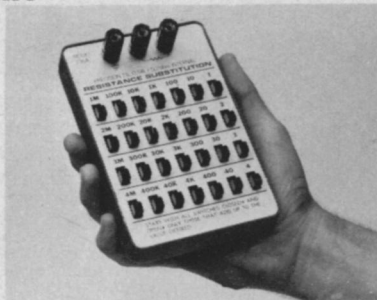

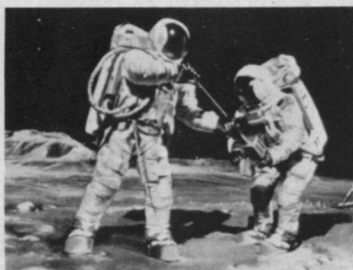

THE ENCYCLOPEDIA OF DOGS: The Canine Breeds—Fiorenzo Fiorone—T. Y. Crowell, 1973, 447 p., color plates, photographs, drawings, \$25. Fully illustrated, features 308 internationally recognized breeds, provides complete official description of each, its history and characteristics.

THE INTERNATIONAL ENCYCLOPEDIA OF CATS—G. N. Henderson and D. J. Coffey, Eds.—McGraw-Hill, 1973, 256 p., 60 color-plates, photographs by Anne Cumbers, drawings by Annabel Milne, \$17.95. Authoritative, non-technical dictionary. Some 700 entries describe every known breed and its care, as well as general subjects from *Abcess* to *Yeast*.

LASERS—O. S. Heavens—Scribner, 1973, 165 p., color plates, diagrams, \$9.95. Gives the nontechnical reader a clear account of how lasers work, how they are likely to develop, what they can do, and what impact they are likely to have in the future.

THE NEUROPSYCHOLOGY OF THIRST: New Findings and Advances in Concepts—Alan N. Epstein, Harry R. Kissileff and Eliot Stellar, Eds.—Winston (Wiley), 1973, 357 p., illus., \$17.50. AAAS Symposium papers and discussions on thirst research during the last decade, the new concept of double depletion hypothesis of thirst, and the pharmacological evidence.

PARENTS' GUIDE TO ALLERGY IN CHILDREN—Claude A. Frazier, M.D., foreword by Stanley F. Hampton, M.D., afterword by Robert M. Heavenrich, M.D.—Doubleday, 1973, 338 p., illus., tables, \$7.95. Up-to-date, easy-to-understand and accurate information on symptoms, causes and management of asthma and other allergies in children.

A new standard work on the Vespoidea, presents a synthesis of current studies and ideas where the work of mathematicians, geneticists, physiologists and ethologists converge.
