
## New Films

CLASSIFYING ANIMALS: AND OUR PLACE IN THE ANIMAL KINGDOM. 16mm, sound, 121/2 min. Designed to help children understand the basic system of classification that is used to identify all living things and to show how human beings relate to the other living creatures of the earth. The film traces the classification of one animal identified by different common names as a puma, cougar mountain lion, and find that it is just one species, (Felis concolor), one of a million different species known to scientists. GREENBACKS. 16mm, color, sound, 29 min. Because our way of life is increasingly dependent on technological processes that pollute, the United States is ten times as polluted as it was in 1948. Polluters do not include the cost of pollution in their prices. However, what is not paid for in one way is paid for in another. Dalton, Georgia, once a rural area and now the prosperous carpet capitol of the United States, has "cashed in" the environment. The carpet industry's massive demand for forty billion gallons of water a day has left the local Conasauga River unable to support life. Audience: secondary, college, adult. LANDMARK. 16mm, color, sound,  $13\frac{1}{2}$  min. The film takes us back 22 years before the present energy shortage, when the United States built the world's first experi-mental breeder reactor. This was the first nuclear-energy machine to produce electrical power anywhere. The breeder will convert nonfissionable uranium-238 into plutonium which can be used to fuel other reactors, free conventional fossil fuels for petrochemical uses, and extend our fuel resources. In this time of growing energy shortages, the film shows how the Government and the American utility industry are gearing up to build and operate a full-scale fast-breeder demonstration plant. 


