**DIVING COMPANIONS**: Sea Lion, Elephant Seal, Walrus—Jacques-Yves Cousteau and Philippe Diolé, transl. from French by J. F. Bernard—Doubleday, 1974, 304 p., 126 color photographs, drawings, maps, glossary, \$10.95. Rare views and observations of marine animals in their habitat, reported by the scientists-adventurers and undersea explorers aboard *Calypso*.

**ECOLOGY AND RECLAMATION OF DEVASTATED LAND**, Vols. I and II—Russell J. Hutnik and Grant David, Eds.—Gordon, 1974, 538 p., 504 p., photographs, diagrams, tables, \$43.20, \$40.80; 2-vol. set: \$72. Based on international symposium proceedings: Vol. I deals with physical and chemical properties, hydrology and pollution, biological changes, and effects on plants. Vol. II discusses species evaluation, modification of adverse conditions, and advances in reclamation.

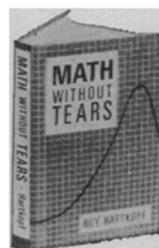
