**ADVICE AND DISSENT:** Scientists in the Political Arena—Joel Primack and Frank von Hippel—Basic Bks. 1974, 310 p., \$12.95. Thoroughly documented, presents in readable form case histories of how independent scientists operate to provide the public and their representatives with factual information needed to make decisions that serve the public interest.

**ANIMAL ARCHITECTURE**—Karl and Otto von Frisch, transl. from German by Lisbeth Gombrich—HarbraceJ, 1974, 313 p., 132 photographs (82 in color), 150 drawings, \$12.95. Covers many different organisms, from sponges, snails, insects, fishes and amphibia to reptiles, birds and mammals, describing their complex building skills and inventiveness.

**ANNUAL REVIEW OF ANTHROPOLOGY**, Vol. 3—Bernard J. Siegel, Alan R. Beals and Stephen A. Tyler, Eds.—Annual Reviews, 1974, 446 p., diagrams, tables, \$15. Topics include theories of culture, ethnomusical research, state formation in Africa, bilingualism, and biochemical evidence of hominid phylogeny.

**COSMETICS:** Science and Technology, Vol. 3—M. S. Balsam and Edward Sagarin, Eds.—Wiley-Interscience, 1974, 2nd ed., 786 p., illus.,

tables, \$36. Complete revision of three-volume work. Deals with status and structure of the cosmetics industry, physiology of skin and of sweating, sensitivity testing, quality control, color in cosmetics, legal considerations, and performance evaluation of cosmetics.

**CREATIVE MALADY:** Illness in the Lives and Minds of Charles Darwin, Florence Nightingale, Mary Baker Eddy, Sigmund Freud, Marcel Proust, Elizabeth Barrett Browning—George Pickering—Oxford U Pr, 1974, 327 p., \$8.95. Physician explores the effect of their illnesses on six creative lives, arguing that psychoneurosis may play an important role in the creative process.

**THE INDIGENOUS TREES OF THE HAWAIIAN ISLANDS**—Joseph F. Rock—Tuttle, 1974, 568 p., 215 photographs, \$22.50. Reissue of pioneering botanical work (1913), showing the endemic Hawaiian forest flora in fine detail.

**LAND FROM THE SEA:** The Geological Story of South Florida—John Edward Hoffmeister—U of Miami Pr, 1974, 143 p., photographs, maps, \$7.95. Marine geologist introduces the layman to the geological history, formations and topography of such features as the Atlantic coastal ridge, mangrove tracts and bays, the Everglades and the Keys.

**THE LAST OF THE NUBA**—Leni Riefenstahl—Har-Row, 1974, 9x12, 208 p., 200 color plates, \$18.95. Outstanding photographic record with captions and narrative, portrays the little-known Mesaki Nuba way of life, isolated in the southern Sudan, untouched by Western influences, pursuing their traditional customs, harvesting, wrestling, and other tribal ceremonies.

**PRIMATES, Comparative Anatomy and Taxonomy VII: CYNOPITHECINAE:** Cercopithecus, Macaca, Cynopithecus—W. C. Osman-Hill—Wiley, 1974, 968 p., 48 plates, drawings, maps, tables, \$75. Monograph covers fully the Mangabeys, Macaques, and Baboon-like Macaques.

**THE UNCERTAIN SEARCH FOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY**—Bruce A. Ackerman et al—Free Pr, 1974, 396 p., diagrams, \$13.95. Critical interdisciplinary analysis of the scientific, economic, political and legal foundations of the water pollution policy currently pursued, with focus on concrete case study of Delaware River Basin Commission decisions.

**WINGS OVER HELLAS:** Ancient Greece from the Air—Raymond V. Schoder—Oxford U Pr, 1974, 256 p., 140 color photographs by author, 138 drawings, maps, \$17.50. Presents in alphabetical order important excavated sites on mainland and islands, from Minoan to Roman times, photographed at oblique angles from the air, with sketch maps and description.

**WOOD HANDBOOK:** Wood as an Engineering Material—U.S. Forest Products Laboratory—USDA Agr. Handb. No. 72, (GPO) 1974, rev. ed., multi-paged, photographs, diagrams, tables, \$7.85. Summarized information on the physical and mechanical properties of woods, and how these properties are affected by variations in the wood itself.

**WORLD PROTEIN RESOURCES**—Allen Jones—Halsted Pr, 1974, 390 p., illus., tables, \$17.50. Treats protein chemistry, the sources and production of animal proteins, vegetable and microbial proteins, deals with protein economics, world supply and demand, and assesses national situations in selected countries.
