AN AMERICAN BESTIARY—Jack Schaefer, foreword by James S. Findley—HM, 1975, 314 p., illus. by Linda K. Powell, \$10. Highly readable, describes a diversity of phenomena observed in the behavior of Southwestern mammals.

ANTOINE-LAURENT LAVOISIER: Chemist and Revolutionary—Henry Guerlac—Scribner, 1975, 174 p., illus., \$7.95; paper, \$2.95. Book-length study of the versatile French scientist's career.

FACT AND FICTION IN B.F. SKINNER'S SCIENCE & UTOPIA (An Essay on Philosophy of Psychology)—R. Puligandla—Green, 1974, 101 p., \$10. Essay examines critically B.F. Skinner's metaphysical assertions about the science of behavior and behavioral utopia, with special reference to his BEYOND FREEDOM AND DIGNITY.

GROWING UP IN AMERICA—Fred M. & Grace Hechinger—McGraw, 1975, 460 p., \$15. A history of American education, reflecting the whole range of high ideals and low prejudices, the cycles of educational reforms and politics, focusing on major personalities, ideas, trends and movements.

A GUIDE TO MEDICINAL PLANTS OF THE UNITED STATES—Arnold & Connie Krochmal—Quadrangle, 1975, 265 p., photographs, drawings, paper, \$4.95. Reprint (1973), describes and depicts 272 plants and lists their medicinal or therapeutic uses.

HANDBOOK OF ENZYME BIOTECHNOLOGY—Alan Wiseman, Ed.—E Horwood (Halsted Pr), 1975, 287 p., \$45. Combines the efforts of a team of British authorities on the subject, establishes systematically theory and practice of large-scale enzyme manufacture and utilization.

HANDBOOK ON THE LABORATORY MOUSE—Charles G. Crispens, Jr.—C C Thomas, 1975, 276 p., tables, paper, \$9.75. Provides student and research worker with tabulated information arranged alphabetically in ten subject groups, covering topics from inbred mouse strains to reproductive and developmental characteristics.

KEEPING FOOD SAFE—Hassell Bradley and Carole Sundberg—Doubleday, 1975, 283 p., tables, \$7.95. Well organized guide to safeguarding the family's health while handling, preparing, preserving, freezing and storing food at home.

METHOD OF MEASURING AND SPECIFYING COLOUR RENDERING PROPERTIES OF LIGHT SOURCES—International Commission on Illumination—CIE, US Nat'l Com-

mittee, 1975, 83 p., tables, paper, \$11. Describes and tabulates the method recommended by CIE (Commission Internationale de L'Eclairage).

NEW FRONTIERS IN ASTRONOMY: Readings from SCIENTIFIC AMERICAN—Introductions by Owen Gingerich—W. H. Freeman, 1975, 369 p., 329 illus., \$13; paper, \$7.50. Documents recent developments in planetary astronomy, solar physics, stellar evolution, galaxies and cosmology.

OF TIME, PASSION AND KNOWLEDGE: Reflections on the Strategy of Existence—J. T. Fraser—Braziller, 1975, 542 p., illus., \$20. An encyclopedic inquiry into the major integrative levels in the study of time—the electromagnetic universe, the world of atomic particles, of aggregate matter, of cyclic and aging orders of life, of mind, and of society; presents the theory of time as a hierarchy of unresolvable conflicts between knowledge felt and knowledge understood.

PASSAGE THROUGH THE GARDEN: Lewis and Clark and the Image of the American Northwest—John Logan Allen—U of Ill Pr, 1975, 438 p., 47 maps, \$18.50. Monograph examines the evolving images of the American Northwest, illustrated with 45 explorers' maps documenting routes explored between 1673 and 1810.

POSITIVE STAINING FOR ELECTRON MICROSCOPY—M. A. Hayat—Van Nos Reinhold, 1975, 382 p., photographs, diagrams, tables, \$27.50. Reference volume on chemical reactions between staining reagents and cellular ligands, describes in detail the preparation of staining solutions and buffers, including procedures for thick sections.

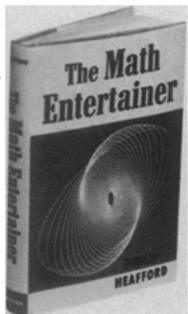

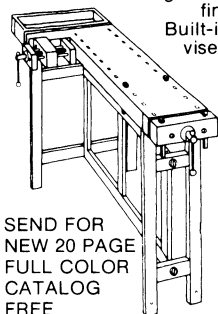
