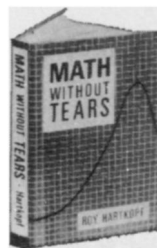

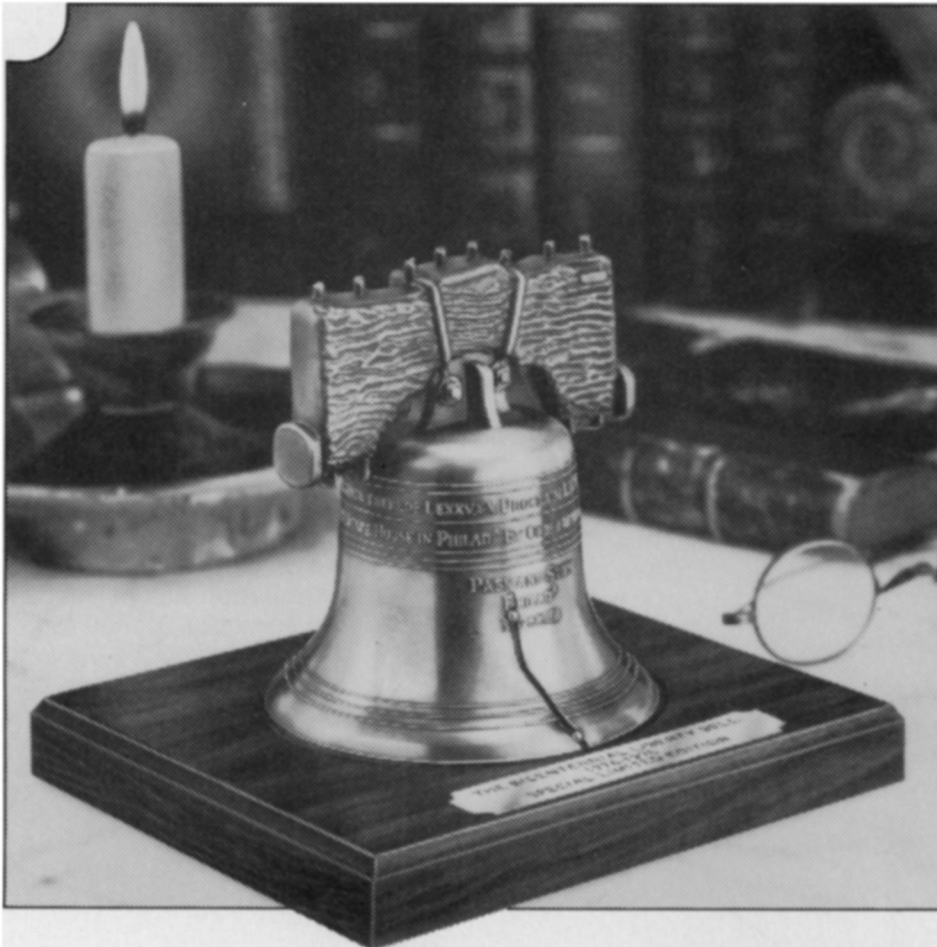

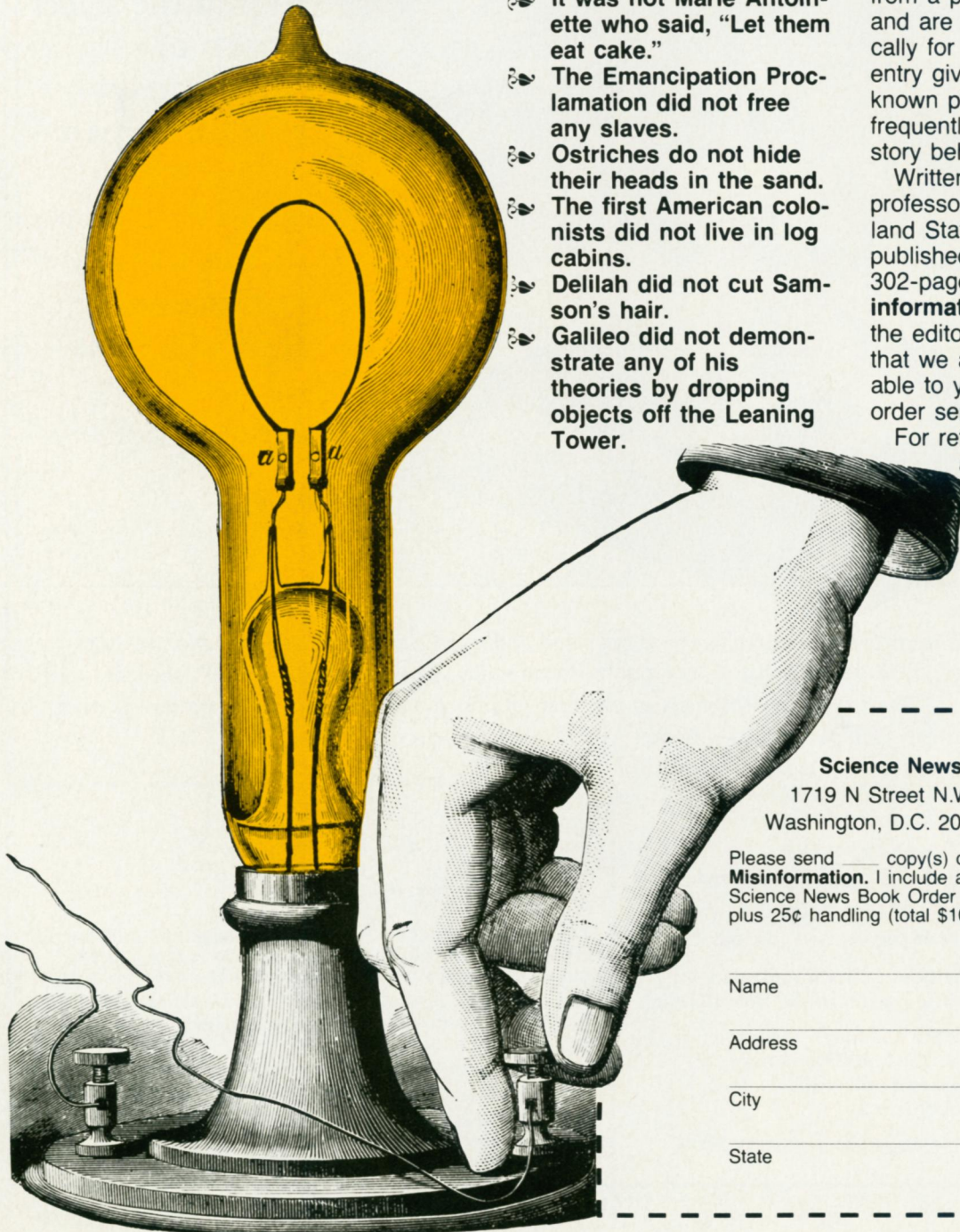
All these nuggets are found in a fascinating new book, **The Dictionary of Misinformation.**
