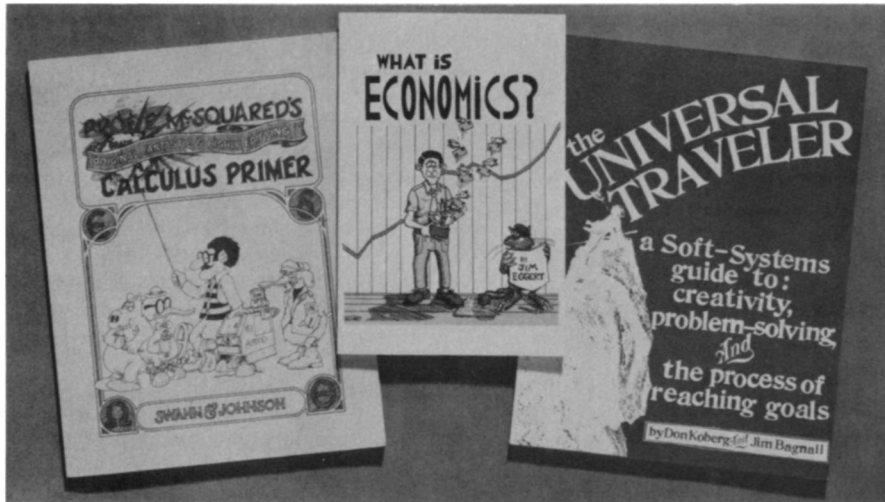


# BOOKS OF FUNDAMENTAL IMPORTANCE

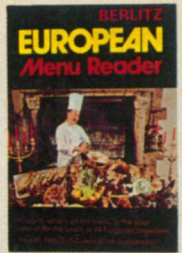
