# The health hazards of NOT going nuclear

Ask not about nuclear hazards without asking what hazards they replace! For example:

#### Accidents and Diseases

Per billion MWh of electricity generated from the corresponding fuel, accidents in mining and transportation plus industrial diseases take 22 lives in the uranium cycle; and 1,259 lives in the coal cycle.

### Waste Disposal

The amount of nuclear wastes is minute (after reprocessing, the volume of an aspirin tablet per person per year); that of coal wastes is enormous (320 lbs per person per year). Nuclear wastes can be sealed in waterproof and even earthquakeproof glass and buried deep in the earth; much of the coal waste goes into the atmosphere and people's lungs, killing thousands by cancer, lung, heart and bronchial diseases every year.

#### **Routine Emissions**

Most coal-fired plants are (due to thorium, radium and other radionuclides in the coal) slightly more radioactive than nuclear plants.

#### Major Disasters

A nuclear disaster could kill 1,000 people, though with a miniscule probability. A dam failure did kill 2,000 (Italy, 1962) and left another 50,000 homeless. LNG tankers, each carrying the energy of a nuclear bomb, dock 21/2 miles from downtown Boston. Some oil storage complexes in the US could, if they caught fire, kill 20,000 people.

## Terrorism and Sabotage

With enormous effort and minute probability, a team of mad scientists could manufacture a bomb from plutonium oxide (not weapongrade plutonium) diverted from the power industry, and they could destroy one, perhaps several, city blocks. No scientists are needed to blow up a dam and kill 100,000 people. Plutonium dispersal would kill victims (by lung cancer) between 10 and 40 years later, making it pointless for terror or blackmail. Unlike chemical or biological toxins, radioactive poisons signal their presence and can be detected in minute quantities.

### And So Forth:

In every single aspect, nuclear power is safer than the forms of power generation with which we live now. By partially replacing them, nuclear power saves lives. 1,600 American lives a year even now; and 200 a year more for every additional percentage point of total generating
