BERING STRAIT: The Regional Physical Oceanography—L. K. Coachman, K. Aagaard and R. B. Tripp—U of Wash Pr, 1976, 186 p., photographs, diagrams, maps, tables, \$20. Study presents observations and measurements concerning variations of water masses, fluctuations of currents, the flow patterns in the Chukchi Sea, and numerical considerations.

CAVES—George Laycock—Four Winds Pr, 1976, 110 p., illus. by De Vere E. Burt, \$6.95. Discusses such aspects of caves as their formation, structure, wildlife inhabitants, vegetation, safety of exploration, and describes several well-known caves.

MATHEMATICS DICTIONARY—James/James—Van Nos Reinhold, 1976, 4th ed., 515 p., diagrams, \$17.95. Revised standard reference, defines nearly 8,000 mathematical terms, expanded to cover probability and statistics. Multilingual index lists terms in French, German, Russian and Spanish.

MOSQUITO ECOLOGY: Field Sampling Methods—M. W. Service—Halsted Pr, 1976, 595 p., diagrams, tables, \$75. Describes the many different methods for collecting mosquitoes, techniques for estimating population size, adult dispersal and survival, sampling of immature stages, and evaluating insecticides.

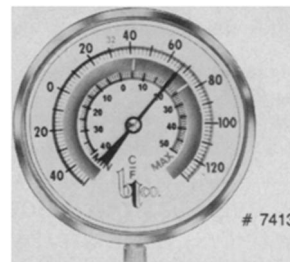

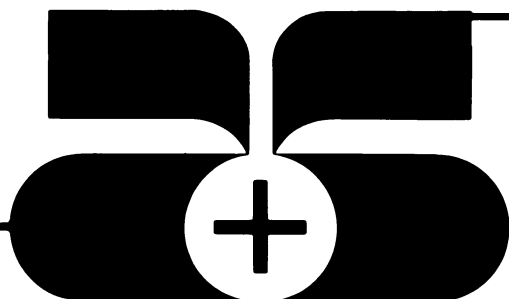
HUMIDITY INDICATOR
