Provides a detailed study of the neurological and physiological mechanisms that control the basic functions of the Mongolian gerbil, develops the links between hormones, genes, olfactory cues and territorial acts.

**THE HIVE AND THE HONEY BEE**—Dadant & Sons, Eds.—Scribner, 1976, rev. ed., 758 p., photographs, drawings, \$14.95. Twenty-seven specialists collaborated in bringing this definitive and practical treatise on beekeeping up-to-date.

**FOOD POWER FROM THE SEA:** The Seaweed Story—Lee Fryer and Dick Simmons—Mason/Charter, 1977, 235 p., illus. by Christine Becker, \$9.95; paper, \$5.95. Deals with the use of seaweeds and fish wastes, and their value as fertilizers. Includes recipes, glossary and directory of suppliers.

**FORCES OF NATURE**—Martin Hodgkate et al.; Sir Vivian Fuchs, Ed.—HR&W, 1977, 9x11, 304 p., color and b&w photographs, diagrams, maps, \$25. Eleven authors, each an expert in his field, describe and explain the nature of the major physical forces which threaten or control human environments—avalanches, blizzards, cyclones, dambursts, deserts, droughts, earthquakes, floods, ice ages, hurricanes, lightning, tornadoes and volcanoes.

**MODERN ASTRONOMY:** Selections from the Yearbooks of Astronomy—Patrick Moore, Ed.—Norton, 1977, 184 p., diagrams, \$9.95. Covering developments in the past 14 years, articles range from Cassegrain reflectors for amateurs, to magnetic stars, and BL Lacertae objects.

**THE MOSCOW PUZZLES:** 359 Mathematical Recreations—Boris A. Kordemsky, transl. from Russian by Albert Parry; Martin Gardner, Ed.—Scribner, 1977, 320 p., illus., paper, \$4.95. For intellectually curious readers who are quick with numbers. Brain teasers of varying difficulty.

**MS. VETERINARIAN**—Mary Price Lee—Westminster Pr, 1976, 140 p., photographs, \$7.50. Deals with the role of women in veterinary medicine, careers in large- and small-animal medicine, research, D.M.V.'s in industry, in public health, and related careers. Discusses preparation for the field, and lists schools.

**MUSICAL ACOUSTICS:** Piano and Wind Instruments—Earle L. Kent, Ed.—DH&R (Halsted Pr), 1977, 376 p., photographs, diagrams, tables, \$34. Selected seminal papers on the science of sound as it relates to the piano, brass instruments and woodwinds, with editor's comments.

**THE OSHA COMPLIANCE MANUAL**—Dan Petersen—McGraw, 1975, 10x11, 225 p., tables, loose-leaf ringbinder, \$29.95. Comprehensive guide to industrial safety, including the most recent Federal Register standards.

**THE PREHISTORIC WORLD**—Angela Sheehan, Ed.—Warwick Pr (Watts), 1976, 160 p., 500 illus. mostly in color, tables, \$5.95. Describes the geological and biological evolution of the earth, from its formation to the development of hominids.

**MENT**—Robert Tillman, Ed.; D. H. Arner, Chmn.—Miss St U (D. H. Arner), 1977, 335 p., photographs, illus. by Tommy Thompson, tables, \$7. Deals with research on ecologically sounder methods of developing rights-of-way of power lines which traverse millions of acres of land in the United States.

**THE SCIENTIFIC STUDY OF MARIHUANA**—Ernest L. Abel, Ed.—Nelson-Hall, 1976, 318 p., tables, \$12.50. Brings together a mass of research findings on the physiological and psychological effects of marihuana.

**TRENDS IN THE SOVIET OIL AND GAS INDUSTRY**—Robert W. Campbell—Johns Hopkins U Pr, 1977, 140 p., maps, tables, \$10. Monograph supplements author's earlier book, deals with major trends since 1965 in activity levels, drilling, oil production and transport, refining and utilization of petroleum products, the gas industry, and international economic relations.

**THE UFO ENIGMA:** The Definitive Explanation of the UFO Phenomenon—Donald H. Menzel and Ernest H. Taves; introd. by Fred L. Whipple—Doubleday, 1977, 310 p., 26 plates, \$8.95. Astronomer and electronics expert evaluate the available records of UFO sightings and other mysteries, in search of scientific support of the evidence, and accounting for the enduring phenomenon of man's credulity.

**THE VANISHING RACE:** Selections from Edward S. Curtis' *The North American Indian*—M. Gidley—Taplinger, 1977, 192 p., 80 photographs, map, \$9.95. Selected text and pictures vividly describe some of the tribal life in its richness of religious beliefs and practices, myths, ceremonies and songs.

**WINTER BIRDS OF THE CAROLINAS AND NEARBY STATES**—Michael A. Godfrey—Blair, 1977, 170 p., color photographs, \$24.95. Provides descriptions and pictures identifying 88 species of birds that normally winter inland in the east, from Pennsylvania to Georgia.

**THE WORKS OF DARWIN:** AN Annotated Bibliographical Handlist—R. B. Freeman—Archon Bks (Shoe String), 1977, rev. ed., 235 p., plates, \$17.50. Annotated list of 1805 items, contains all the editions and issues of books, pamphlets and circulars, both British and foreign, recorded from the first in 1835 to the end of 1975, as well as list of papers, notes and letters originally published in serials.

**THE WORLD OF CAVES**—A. C. Waltham—Putnam, 1977, 9x12, 128 p., color photographs, maps, \$12.95. Explores the spectacular formation of subterranean passages and waters, stalaktites and stalagmites, rock paintings, fauna, and the construction of the famous caverns of the world.

**WORLD GUIDE TO MAMMALS**—Nicole Duplaix and Noel Simon; introd. by Prue and John Napier—Crown, 1977, 284 p., 275 illus. in color by Peter Barrett, 152 range maps, \$15.95. Describes 812 species, gives essential information about appearance, size, distribution, behavior and breeding habits, incorporating latest findings.

**WRITTEN COMMUNICATION FOR DATA PROCESSING**—Randi Sigmund Smith—Van Nos Reinhold, 1976, 200 p., \$12.95. Stresses clear, concise communication skills; provides guidelines for preparing effective review memos, status reports, information memos, management reports, and inquiry responses.
