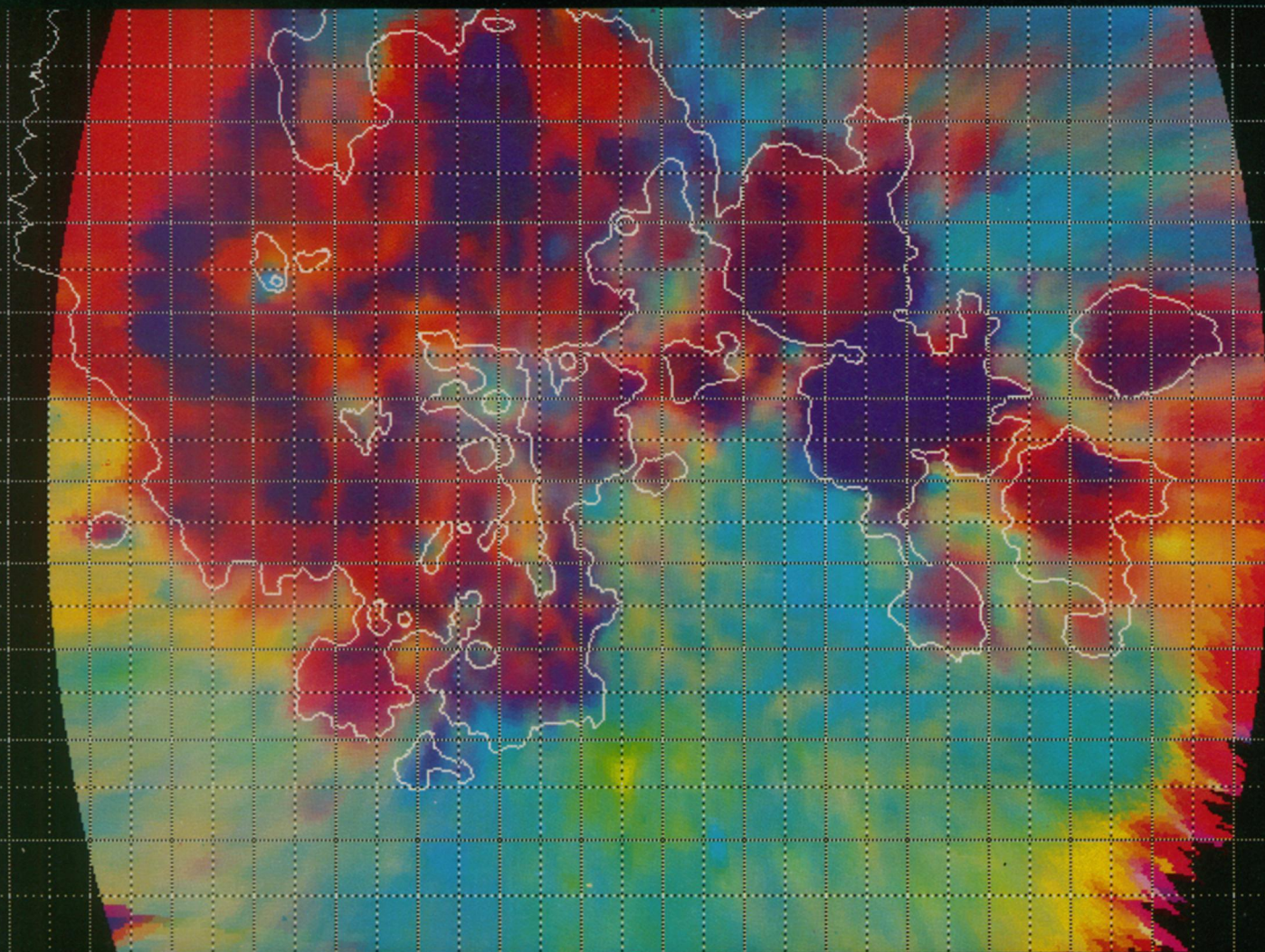


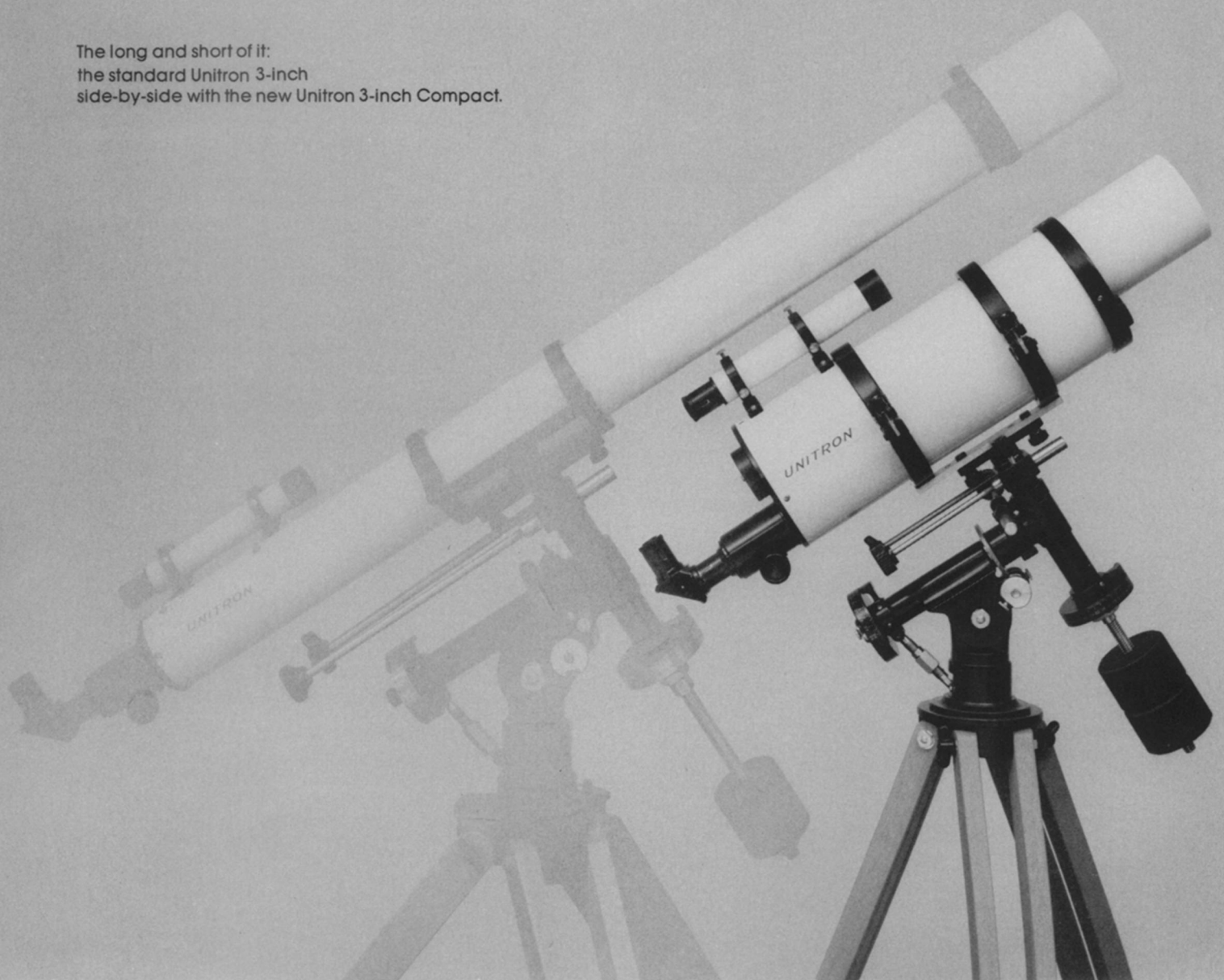

Now you can put the sun, the moon, the stars, the planets, the Crab Nebula and the Milky Way in a wooden carrying case only 9 inches square and 20 inches high. Unitron's new 3-inch Compact refractor telescope — the first of its kind commercially available — is housed in a tube only 19 inches long, five inches in diameter. It gives you the optical advantages of a refractor plus portability.

You get an achromatic, air-spaced, multi-coated objective with a three-inch (75mm) aperture. It has a 1200mm focal length, f/16 focal ratio, 2.5 sec resolving power, 11.2 magnitude reach. Six coated eyepieces: 48x, 67x, 96x, 131x, 171x and 200x. The viewfinder is 8x, 30mm.

The sturdy tripod with famous Unitron equatorial mount has slow-motion controls on both axes, flexible cable control for right ascension, engraved setting circles, provision for motor drive. Precision rack-and-pinion focusing, erecting prism, star diagonal with achromatic



amplifier, sun projection screen set, carrying case. All this for less than \$700!
