ANCIENT MYSTERIES—Peter Haining linger, 1977, 178 p., drawings & photographs, \$9.95. Reviews the major mysteries of the earth that have particular interest for English-speaking peoples and discusses the various viewpoints that have been advanced about such mysteries as Atlantis, Stonehenge, phantom islands and UFO's.

ANNUAL REVIEW OF NUCLEAR SCI-ENCE, Vol. 27—Emilio Segrè et al, Eds.—Annual Reviews, 1977, 568 p., illus., \$19.50. Topics range from spontaneously fissioning isomers to damped heavy-ion collisions.

THE ART AND SCIENCE OF INVENTING —Gilbert Kivenson—Van Nos Reinhold, 1977, 195 p., drawings, \$11.95. A practical manual which shows the independent inventor how to proceed in a logical, professional way toward the successful development and utilization of an invention.

CHEMISTRY IN MEDICINE: The Legacy and the Responsibility — ACS Committee on Chemistry and Public Affairs—Am Chemical, 1977, 138 p., paper, \$7.50. Focuses on the contribution of chemistry in understanding how biological systems function and in developing therapeutic products and diagnostic procedures. Discusses society's attitudes and how various laws and regulations pertaining to therapeutic practices affect research.

CHILD MALTREATMENT IN THE UNITED STATES: A Challenge to Social Institutions— Saad Z. Nagi—Columbia U Pr, 1977, 162 p., charts & graphs, \$8.00. Examines the rights of children and parents, the status of knowledge and technology, the relative merits of punitive versus therapeutic approaches and the domains of organizations and professionals involved.

ENERGY FOR DEVELOPMENT: THIRD WORLD OPTIONS — Denis Hayes — Worldwatch Inst., 1977, 43 p., paper, \$2. The current high cost of power from other sources has already made solar energy economically competitive in rural areas of Asia, Africa and Latin America, according to the author, and the Third World may gain a jump on the U.S. and Europe in making the transition to solar power.

ETHICAL ISSUES IN DEATH AND DYING — Robert F. Weir, Ed. — Columbia U Pr. 1977, 405 p., \$20, paper, \$8. Articles dealing with truth-telling, determining death, euthanasia and suicide which are intended to show that the attitudes of fear and fascination of death may inhibit decisionmaking at the critical time, and pointing up the interface of the medical, legal and religious/philosophical professions as they deal with death and, more particularly, with the treatment of persons near death.

ETHNIC MEDICINE IN THE SOUTHWEST Edward H. Spicer, Ed.—U of Ariz Pr, 1977, 291 p., \$16.50, paper, \$6.95. Discusses medical traditions which exist in present-day societies but which are out of touch with "Western medicine." Mexican American, Black, Arizona Yaqui and lower-income Anglo communities are studied.

EXPERIMENTAL ARCHEOLOGY Ingersoll et al, Eds. — Columbia U Pr, 1977, 423 p., illus., \$25. A collection of papers that address the question of how the archaelogist can use observable present-day events or processes and laboratory experiments to understand past human behavior.

THE ILUSTRATED ENCYCLOPEDIA OF ARCHAEOLOGY — Glyn Daniel, Ed. — TY Crowell, 1977, 224 p., illus., \$17.95. A readable reference work for the general reader, the student and the professional with entries on the significant sites, cultures and civilizations discovered by archaeologists; the terms, tools and techniques of archaeology as well as outstanding archaeologists.

AN ILLUSTRATED HISTORY OF THE **HERBALS**—Frank J. Anderson—Columbia U Pr. 1977, 270 p., illus., \$16.95. Herbals are books that were generally concerned with plants having medicinal properties. This history surveys the most important works from the first to the 16th century.

MOUNTAIN MONARCHS: Wild Sheep and Goats of the Himalaya — George B. Schaller — U of Chicago Pr. 1977, 425 p., illus., \$25. Surveys the geographical and ecological distribution of these animals giving their physical attributes, population pressures and social behavior.

OUT OF THIS WORLD: American Space Photography — Paul Dickson with foreword by R. Buckminster Fuller — Dell, 1977, 158 p., color and b&w photographs, paper, \$9.95. Tells the story of how the space photograph effort began and developed (the first astronauts did not even take cameras with them into space), discusses uses of these photographs and includes a selection of spectacular space photographs.


