BIOLOGY IN THE NINETEENTH CENTURY: Problems of Form, Function, and Transformation — William Coleman — Cambridge U Pr, 1977, 187 p., illus., \$13.95, paper, \$5.95. Originally published in 1971, this book is now a part of the Cambridge History of Science series.

FEAR: Learning to Cope — Albert G. Forgione et al — Van Nos Reinhold, 1978, 175 p., \$9.95. A layman's guide to the understanding and treatment of fear with emphasis on self-help.

A FIELD GUIDE TO EDIBLE WILD PLANTS: Eastern and Central North America — Lee Peterson — HM, Peterson Field Guide Series, 1978, 330 p., b&w drawings and color photographs, \$8.95. Information for identifying, harvesting and preparing nearly 400 species. Plants are described and well illustrated. Common poisonous plants that resemble edible ones are discussed and depicted.

A GUIDE TO THE BIRDS OF VENEZUELA — Rodolphe Meyer de Schauensee and William H. Phelps, Jr. — Princeton U Pr, 1978, 424 p., color and b&w drawings, \$50; paper, \$19.95. South America is inhabited by no less than 2,936 different species of birds, and about 44 percent of these can be found within the boundaries of Venezuela. Black and white or color drawings illustrate each of nearly 1,300 birds described.

IN SEARCH OF ANCIENT ASTRONOMIES—E. C. Krupp, Ed.—Doubleday, 1978, 300 p., photographs and drawings, \$10. An attempt to present to the general reader a balanced perspective of the field of archaeoastronomy by the Director of the Griffith Observatory, Los Angeles.

LANGUAGE ACQUISITION AND LANGUAGE BREAKDOWN: Parallels and Divergencies — Alfonso Caramazza and Edgar B. Zurif, Eds.—Johns Hopkins, 1978, 339 p., charts and graphs, \$17.50. The articles attempt to determine whether the linguistic forms acquired latest in development are the most vulnerable in aphasia and whether those learned earliest are the best retained.

MEDICINE AND THE REIGN OF TECHNOLOGY — Stanley Joel Reiser — Cambridge U Pr, 1978, 317 p., illus., \$14.95. Describes some of the technological advances made in medicine and shows how those advances altered diagnostic methods and, in turn, the relationship between physician and patient.
