**ANCIENT BURIAL PATTERNS OF THE MOCHE VALLEY, PERU** — Christopher B. Donnan and Carol J. Mackey—U of Tex Pr, 1978, 412 p., illus., \$24.95. Focuses on the pre-Columbian burials excavated in the Moche Valley since 1969. Provides descriptions of 103 burials, spanning a period of more than 3,500 years. Includes illustrations of every artifact found and describes their placement, and gives details on the location, matrix, construction and occupant of the graves.

**ANTIBODIES AND IMMUNITY** — G.J.V. Nossal—Basic, 2nd ed., 1978, 310 p., illus., \$11.95. Presents the subject of immunology in language intelligible to the nonscientist who has virtually no background in biology. The first edition (1969) was awarded the Phi Beta Kappa Science Award. This edition has been revised and expanded to include the important new knowledge that has accumulated in immunology in the last decade.

**THE BIOLOGY OF THE PIG** — Wilson G. Pond and Katherine A. Houpt—Cornell U Pr, 1978, 371 p., illus., \$22.50. Discusses the pig as a model in biomedical research and discusses behavior, prenatal and postnatal development, lactation and the mammary glands, anesthesia, blood sampling and surgery, body fluids, hematology and immunology, nutrition, husbandry, handling and restraint. Includes extensive bibliographies with each chapter.

**CURRENT PEDIATRIC DIAGNOSIS & TREATMENT** — C. Henry Kempe et al—Lange, 5th ed., 1978, 1102 p., charts & graphs, paper, \$17. The aim is to present the basic principles of diagnosis and treatment in sufficient detail to cover management of a patient in clinical practice along with current references for more detailed study.

**DEER** — Raymond E. Chaplin—Blandford Pr (Sterling), 1977, 218 p., illus., \$11.95. The author, who has devoted his life to the study of deer, presents new scientific information in this book that discusses the life cycle, behavior and diseases of this animal which is found the world over. Beautiful color and b&w photographs enhance the text.
