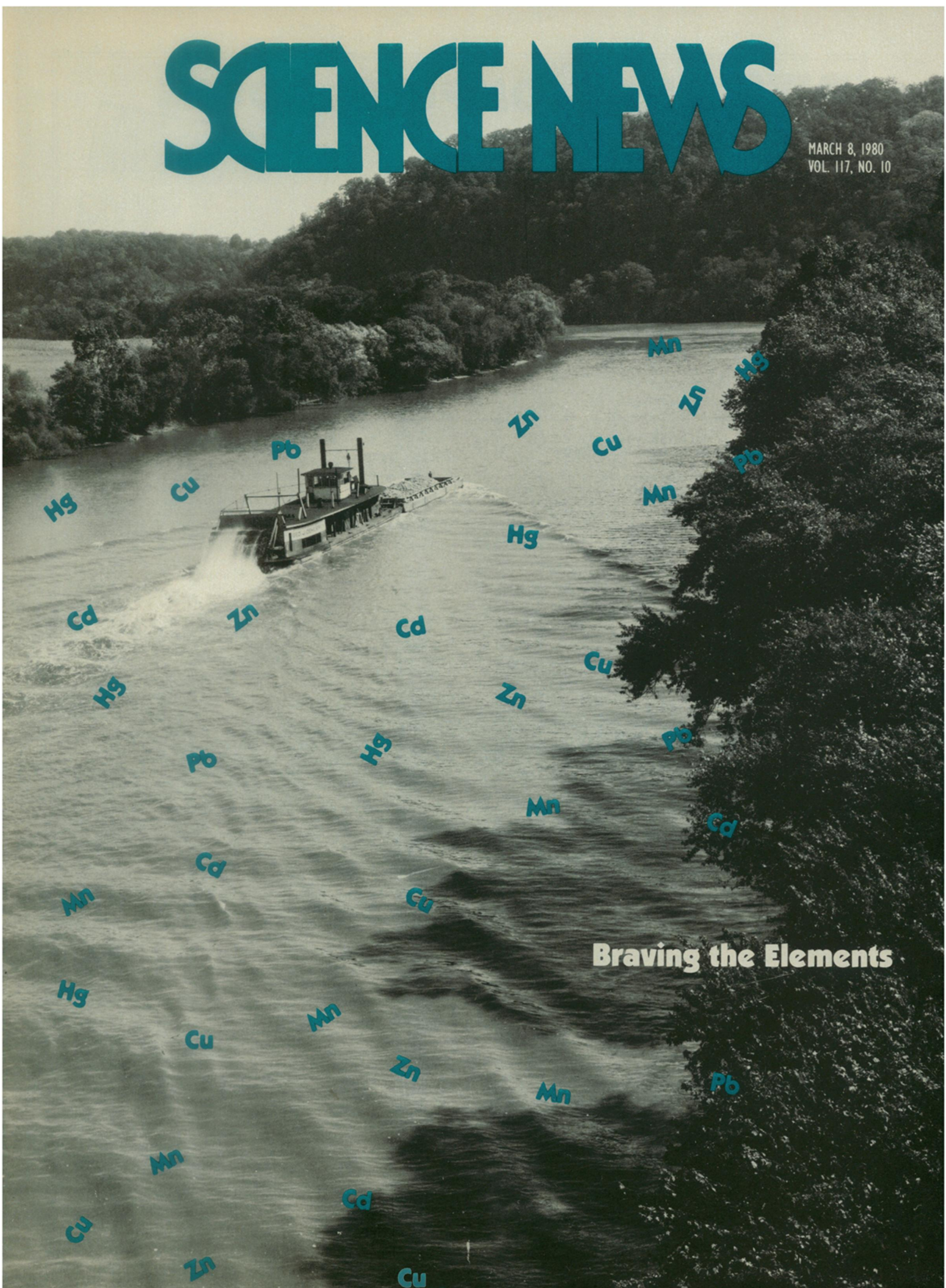

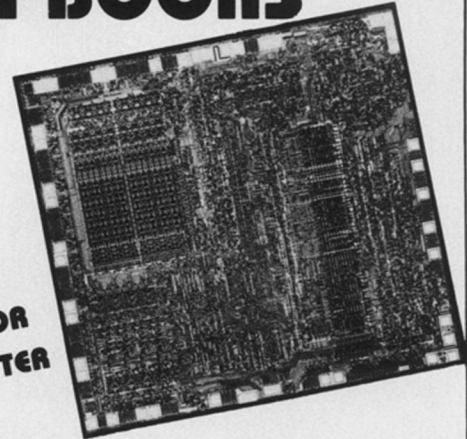

## **MATHEMATICAL ELEMENTS FOR COMPUTER GRAPHICS** by David F. Rogers and J. Alan Adams

This book introduces computer graphics technology and the math used in computer processing of graphics. The main concentration is on the matrix algebra used to transform (rotation, scaling, reflection, translation, projection, etc.) images represented by computer. Also covered are plane and space curve representation, and surface description and generation. The appendices include background material on matrix operations and over 30 programs in extended BASIC for processing computer graphics. If graphics is your application, this is the place to start. 239pp. #135 \$12.95

## **An Important New Book**

### **GODEL, ESCHER, BACH: AN ETERNAL GOLDEN BRAID** by Douglas R. Hofstadter

Culling underlying themes from several different disciplines is an artful and enlightening talent. Douglas Hofstadter has accomplished this, and in doing so has made very abstract mathematical ideas clear to the general reader. Self-reference and interplay between levels are found in Bach's music, Escher's drawings, and then presented in Godel's Theorem. Hofstadter follows these ideas down a long trail which includes mathematics, physics, computers, the genetic chemistry of DNA, Zen Buddhism, and artificial intelligence, among others. Each step of the way is illuminated with the dialogues of characters taken from the history of mathematics. The book is a rare gem. 777pp. Hardcover #256 \$20.00

## **BASIC BASIC, 2nd EDITION** by James S. Coan

**Basic BASIC** gives you step-by-step instructions for using a terminal, writing programs, using loops and lists, solving mathematical problems, understanding matrices and more. The book contains a wealth of illustrations and example programs, and is suitable for beginners on many different levels. It makes a fine reference for the experienced programmer, too. 256pp. #014 \$9.45

## **PROGRAMMING IN PASCAL** by Peter Gorgono

This book is an excellent introduction to one of the fastest growing programming languages today. The text is arranged as a tutorial containing both examples and exercises to increase reader proficiency in PASCAL. Besides sections on procedures and files, there is a chapter on dynamic data structures such as trees and linked lists. These concepts are put to use in an example bus service simulation. 359pp. #099 \$11.50

## **SCIENTIFIC AND ENGINEERING PROBLEM SOLVING WITH THE COMPUTER** by William Ralph Bennett

Besides teaching BASIC (which it does admirably), this lively, lucid book presents a wealth of imaginative and illustrative applications programs and simulations taken from many disciplines. The exercises run the gamut from matrix algebra to cryptography, from rocket travel to lasers. You'll discover BASIC applications in math, graphics, physics, engineering, communication and language. 457pp. #107 \$20.95

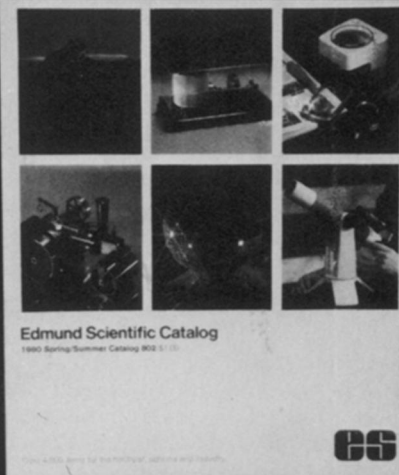
