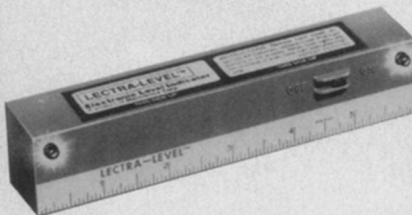

Joan Arehart-Treichel. Medical and behavioral studies reveal that there are particular personality types, "biotypes," that in time of stress break down in specific and predictable ways.
