Lilienthal, the first chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, in his book written for the general reader, says that we do not yet have a safe method of producing electricity by nuclear means. He explains how we arrived at this point, the need for nuclear energy and the necessity for exploring neglected but promising alternatives to current technology. Har-Row, 1980, 124 p., \$8.95.

CHILD'S EYE VIEW: A New Way of Understanding the Development and Behavior of Children — Carol Tomlinson-Keasey. Provides information about normal growth and development of children so that parents can understand and deal with both the problems and pleasures that children bring.
