**ASTRONOMY OF THE ANCIENTS**—Kenneth Brecher and Michael Feirtag, Eds. Philip Morrison in the introduction indicates that this is a reconstruction of the past of the human mind, using all the evidence we have—text, myth and space—but with a difference. The difference is that in astronomy phenomena can be invoked today to challenge or to support the inferences of the archaeologist, epigrapher, historian or mythologist. **DDT: Scientists, Citizens, and Public Policy**—Thomas R. Dunlap. An attempt to place the controversy over DDT policy in historical perspective. The author feels that a history of the involvement of scientists and citizens in the making of policy on this issue could shed light on the social history of science in America. **ENGINEERING IN THE ANCIENT WORLD**—J. G. Landels. Discusses technological achievements of the Greeks and Romans to give the general reader insight into the outstanding mechanical skills of these civilizations. Originally published in hardback in 1978. U of Cal Pr, 1981, 224 p., illus., paper, \$4.95.

**MEDICINE AND THE REIGN OF TECHNOLOGY**—Stanley Joel Reiser. Describes some of the technological advances made in medicine and shows how those advances altered diagnostic methods and, in turn, the relationship between physician and patient. Originally published in hardback in 1978. Cambridge U Pr, 1981, 317 p., illus., paper, \$8.95.

**THE NATURAL HISTORY OF THE GORILLA**—A. F. Dixon, foreword by R. D. Martin. Describes in detail gorilla distribution and classification, structure and evolutionary relationships. Much attention is given to gorilla behavior, reproduction and development, senses and intelligence. The present status of the species is discussed in the face of massive destruction of the rain forests. Columbia U Pr, 1981, 202 p., illus., \$19.95.

**THE NEW SOLAR SYSTEM**—J. Kelly Beatty, Brian O'Leary and Andrew Chaikin, Eds., introduction by Carl Sagan. A beautifully illustrated book describing the new knowledge of our solar system, with chapters by scientists who have been involved in the recent research on our corner of the universe. Cambridge U Pr & Sky Pub, 1981, 224 p., color/b&w illus., \$19.95.

**NUTRITION AND HEALTH ENCYCLOPEDIA**—David F. Tver and Percy Russell. The subject of nutrition is broad and covers many sciences—from molecular biology, physiology and chemistry to medicine. This one-volume illustrated encyclopedia defines and explains terminology relevant to nutrition. Van Nos Reinhold, 1981, 569 p., illus., \$26.50.

**PARANORMAL BORDERLANDS OF SCIENCE**—Kendrick Frazier, Ed. The chapters in this book are taken from the inquiries and investigations that have appeared in the *Skeptical Inquirer*, a journal published by the Committee for the Scientific Investigation of Claims of the Paranormal.
