**COMPUTER DICTIONARY FOR EVERYONE** — Donald D. Spencer. Terms are defined in nontechnical language. Where special terminology is required, the expression used is carefully defined. Related terms or concepts are indicated by cross references. Originally published in hardback in 1979. Scribner, 1981, 191 p., illus., paper, \$5.95.

**DAYTIME STAR: The Story of Our Sun** — Simon Mitton. Outlines our present understanding of the sun — a fascinating story involving physics, astrophysics, history, space research and energy research. Scribner, 1981, 191 p., illus., \$14.95.

**THE FISHES AND THE FOREST: Explorations in Amazonian Natural History** — Michael Goulding. Offers evidence that a large number of the Amazon's fishes are fed by the seeds and fruits produced by the flooded forests. The fish, in turn, aid in the reproduction of the trees by carrying the seeds further downstream. Intended to contribute to the understanding of the tropical ecosystem and, it is hoped, to the preservation of this unique jungle and river area. **A GOLDEN THREAD: 2500 Years of Solar Architecture and Technology** — Ken Butti and John Perlin. The ancient Greeks designed their homes to capture the winter sunlight. This book describes the major advances in solar architecture and technology that have occurred since the days of those ingenious people. Originally published in hardback in 1980. Cheshire, 1981, 291 p., illus., paper, \$9.95.

**MISSING LINKS: The Hunt for Earliest Man** — John Reader. A history of paleoanthropology that brings new information and insights to the early phases of the story and gives detailed coverage of the contemporary history up to 1980. The text is enhanced by beautiful color photographs. Little, 1981, 272 p., color illus., \$19.95.

**MUSEUMS OF THE WORLD** — J. Benson et al. Eds. A reference guide to more than 18,000 museums of all kinds that are located in 163 countries. Each entry gives the museum's name, address, type, founding date and brief description of collections and facilities. Names and addresses of 26 international museum organizations and national organizations active in 34 countries worldwide are included. Saur (Gale), 3rd rev. ed., 1981, 623 p., \$185.

**SPACE SCIENCE COMES OF AGE: Perspectives in the History of the Space Sciences** — Paul A. Hanle and Von Del Chamberlain, Eds. Chronicles the emergence of the space sciences by founders and pioneers in the field and professional historians. **WORLD ENERGY: The Facts and the Future** — Don Hedley. Examines how energy is used in the world and how much energy is used; fuel resources — where they are, how long they will last, which countries have the fuel and which countries need it the most; the implications of the energy crisis for transportation; the development of synthetic fuels; the impact of conservation; the renewable energy sources and what progress is being made with them. 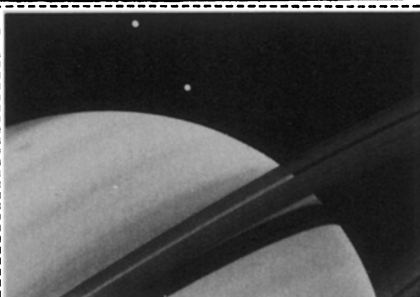

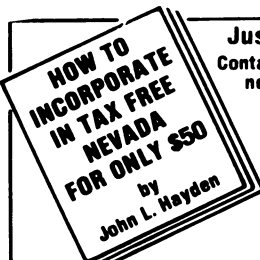
