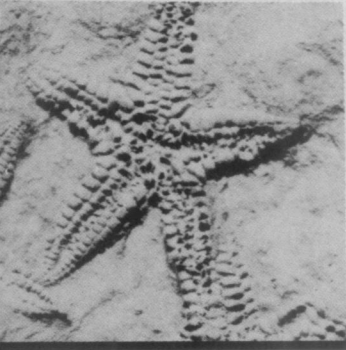

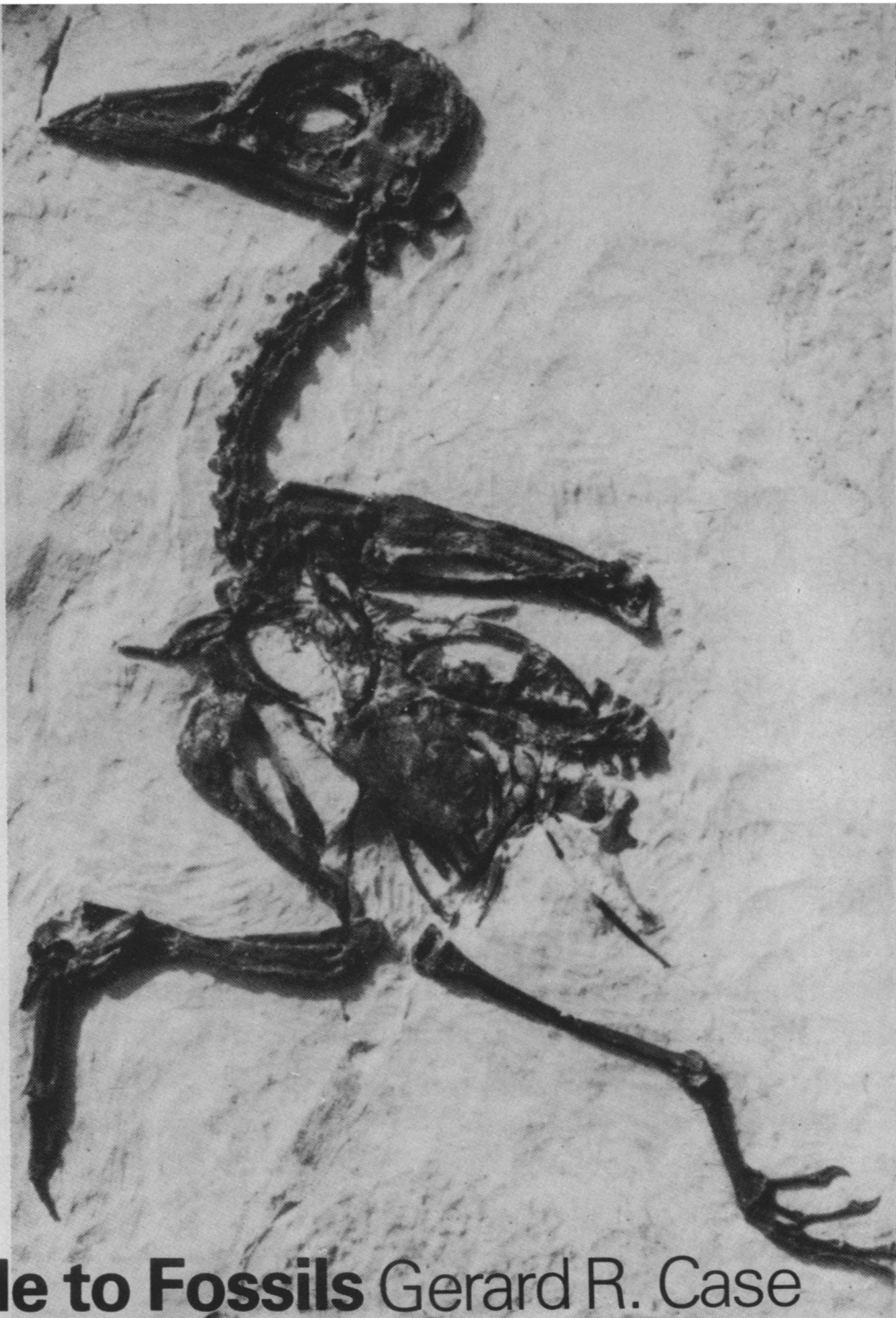

Digging for fossil specimens is rewarding, but only if you know what you're looking for and what you've found.

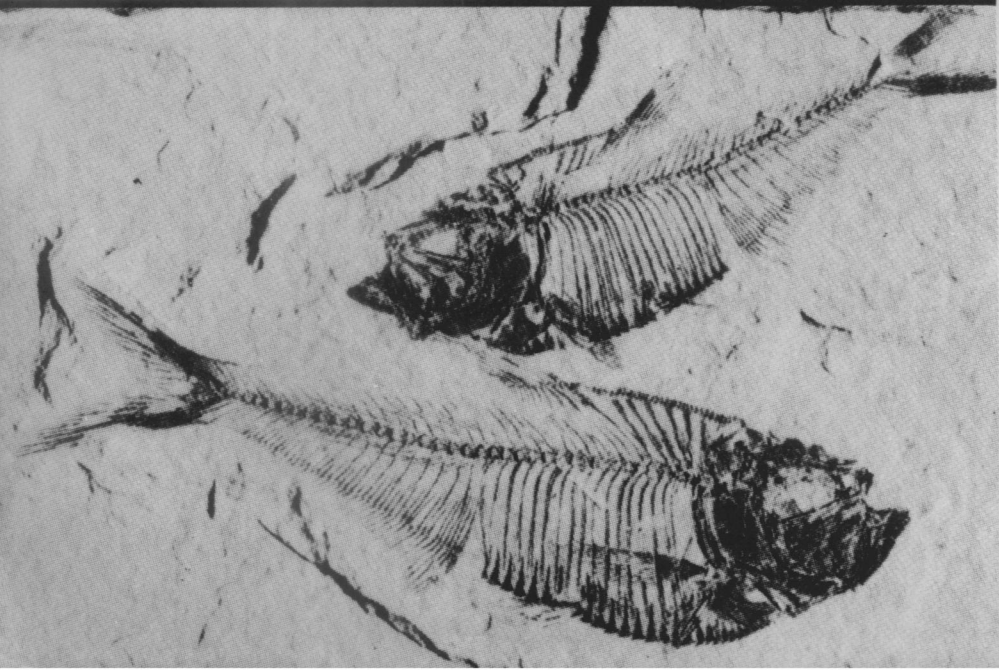
A Pictorial Guide to Fossils is a reference book that identifies and classifies fossils to be found around the world.
