

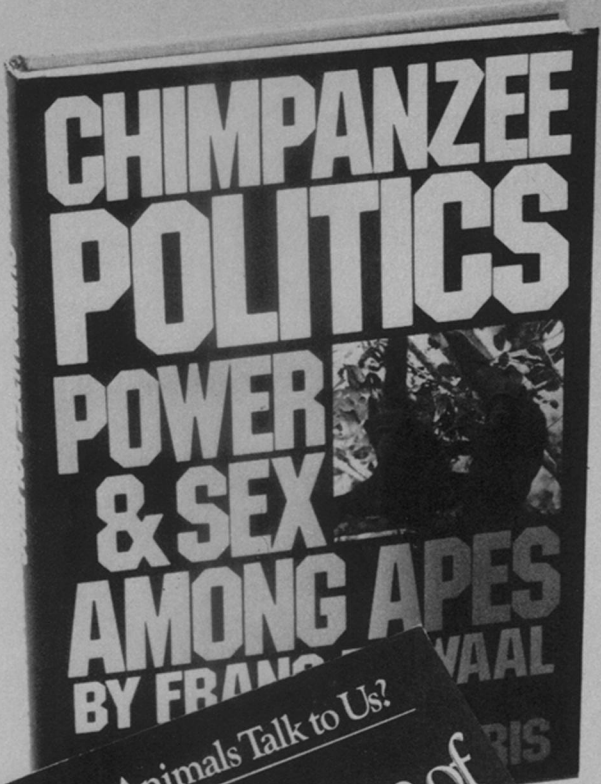

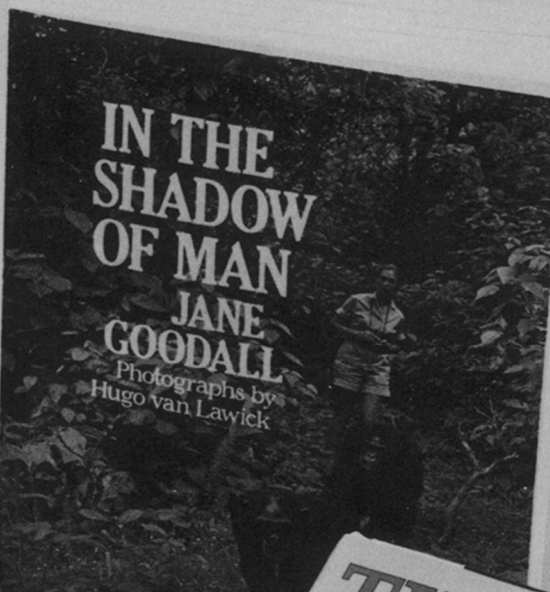




Chimpanzee Politics By Frans De Waal

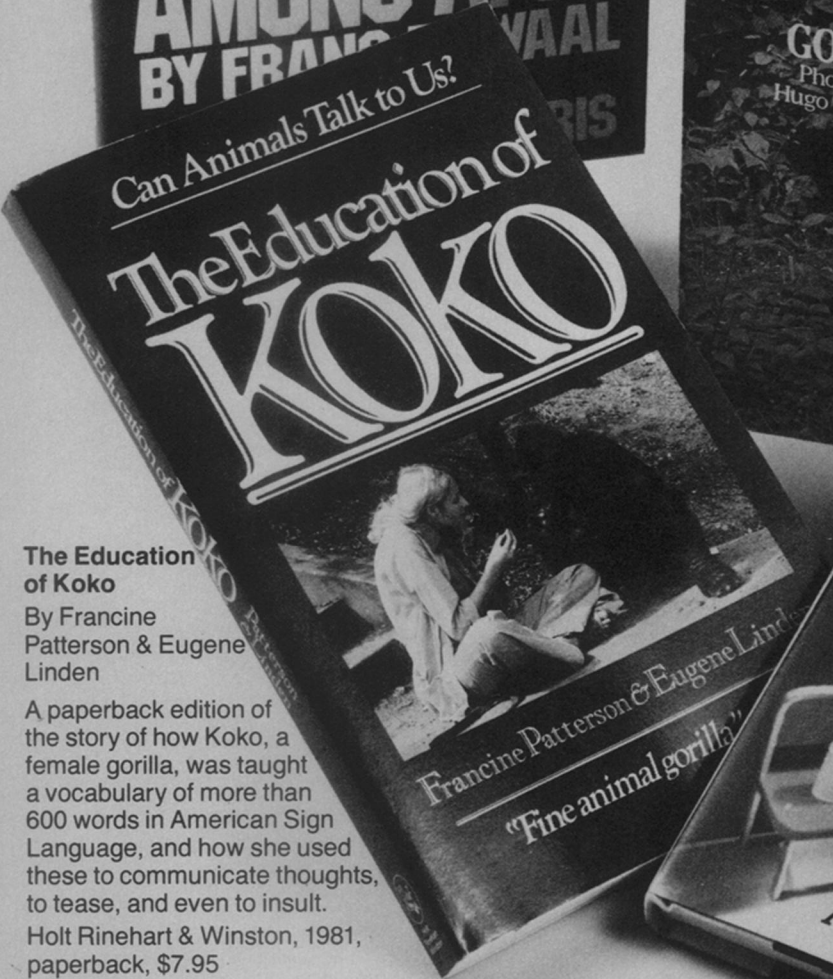

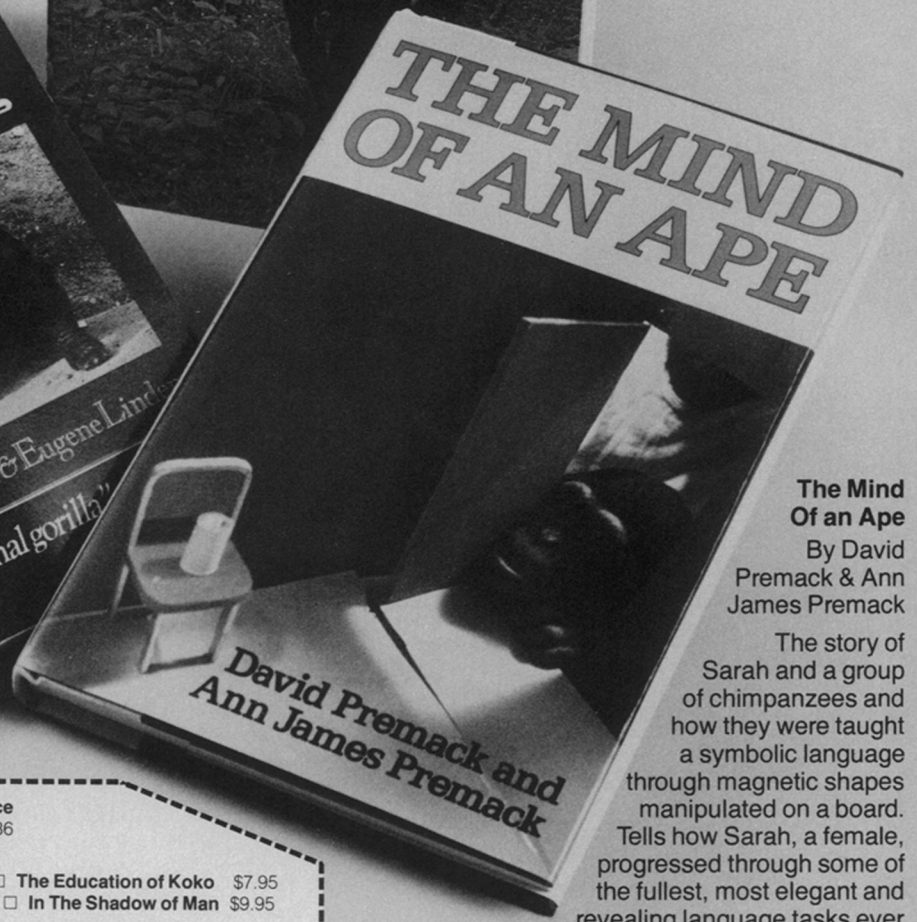


The Education of Koko
