A Basket of Herbs: A Book of American Sentiments — Mary Mason Campbell et al, Eds. For each herb the history, lore, sentimental and symbolic significance is outlined followed by literary quotations about the herb. Greene, 1983, 185 p., color/b&w illustrations by Tasha Tudor, \$12.95.

Birds of Southern California's Deep Canyon —Wesley W. Weathers. Deep Canyon links one of North America's hottest and driest regions, the Colorado Desert, with the conifer forests of Southern California Peninsular Mountain Range. A comprehensive account of the abundance, diversity and natural history of bird life along this canyon. U of Cal Pr, 1983, 266 p., color/b&w illus. \$35.


The Heroin Solution — Arnold S. Trebach. This book attempts to "combine the story of heroin in ordinary medicine — the treatment of the organically ill or injured — with the related and more familiar story of its use in the addiction arena, whether by addicts or by the doctors treating them." It provides a comprehensive account of the heroin experience of both Britain and the U.S. and offers specific recommendations for dealing with the heroin problem. Originally published in hardback in 1982. Yale U Pr, 1983, 331 p. \$9.95.

Minerals, Rocks, and Fossils — R. V. Dietrich and Reed Wicander. A self-teaching guide that tells how minerals, rocks and fossils were formed and what can be learned about the earth's history in their shapes, colors and patterns. Suggests where to hunt for these geological specimens and how to handle and display them. Tables included aid in mineral and rock identification. Wiley, 1983, 212 p., illus., paper,

Orderly Tangles: Cloverleafs, Gordian Knots, and Regular Polylinks — Alan Holden. Explores topological phenomena such as rings, knots and chains. Starts with the highway interchange, then discusses our oldest purposeful tangles, those of weaving and its ancestor, basketry. Knots that cannot be untied and the cat's cradle are examined. Introduces the idea of "regular polylinks" and pursues some of its consequences in the last three chapters. Well illustrated. Columbia U Pr, 1983, 97 p., illus., \$19.95.

A Search for Structure: Selected Essays on Science, Art, and History — Cyril Stanley Smith. Essays that point out the unity between aesthetic curiosity and scientific and technological discovery. Originally published in hardback in 1981. MIT Pr, 1983, 410 p., illus., paper, \$15.

The World of the Ancient Maya — John S. Henderson. A survey of the Mayan cultural tradition. Introduces the societies that were a part of it and explores their contrasts, connections and linked historical development. Originally published in hardback in 1981. Cornell U Pr, 1983, 271 p., illus., paper, \$12.95.
