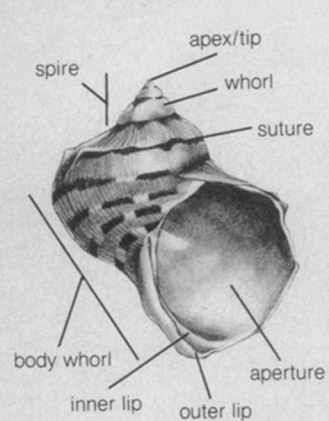

And also 40 pages of appendices giving complete structural specifications of the craft and its systems, a glossary of NASA terms and acronyms, and a plan of the Kennedy Space Center.
