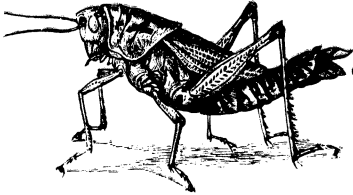


Tools for Gardening

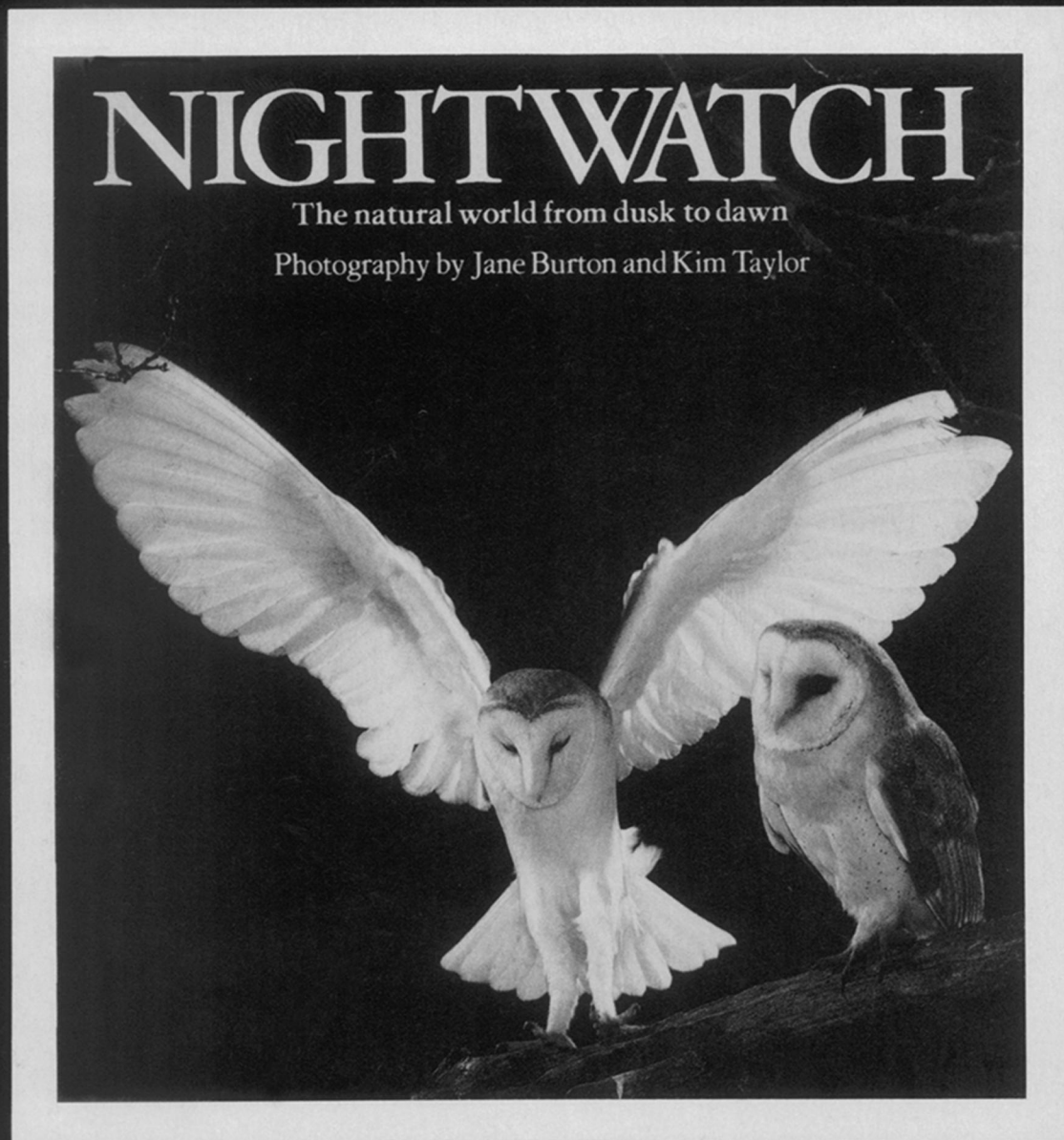
