"From Earth to Mars" – including a history of Mars One, spacecraft familiarization and orientation and an overview of the Mars mission

"Living and Working in Space" – with sections on food, clothing, exercise, psychological factors and medical facilities

"Outbound Leg" – includes in-flight training schedules, the Venus swing-by and navigation

"Mars Activities" – a run-through of orbital activities, descent and landing procedures, Mars surface activities and information on the Mars Rover

"Inbound Leg" – describes the inbound schedule, quarantine procedures and Earth arrival

"Maintenance" – profile of the Mars One on-board systems, including communications, engines, life support, and in-flight maintenance

"Mars Science Reference" – describes characteristics of the planet, including the atmosphere, the surface geology and the Martian moons

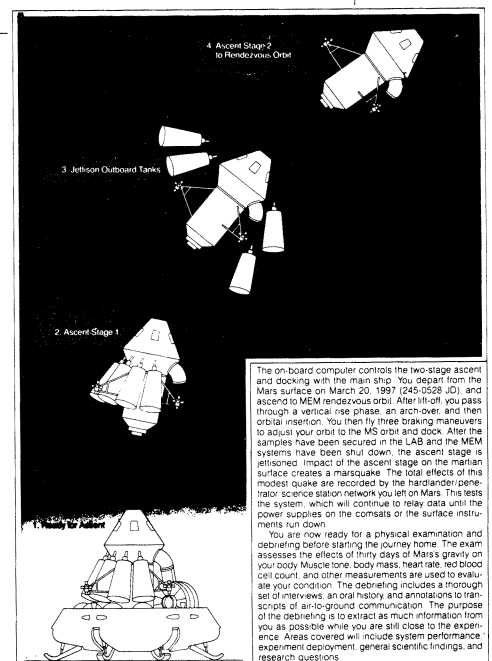
This manual is your flight reference guide. It contains basic flight information, important training data, and reference material. Remember that this manual will have to last the length of your mission, over two years, so treat it well!
