1987 Directory of Science Training Programs for High Ability Precollege Students

The directory lists institutions in the United States that will be conducting student science training programs in the summer of 1987 and the academic year 1987-88. The 447 programs listed are of three general types: research, courses, or combination research and courses. Residential and commuter programs are offered; some charge for participation, some do not. Scholarships are available for many.

These programs are designed to provide talented precollege (mostly high school) students with educational opportunities in science, engineering and mathematics beyond those normally available in courses or laboratory work in the students' schools.
