

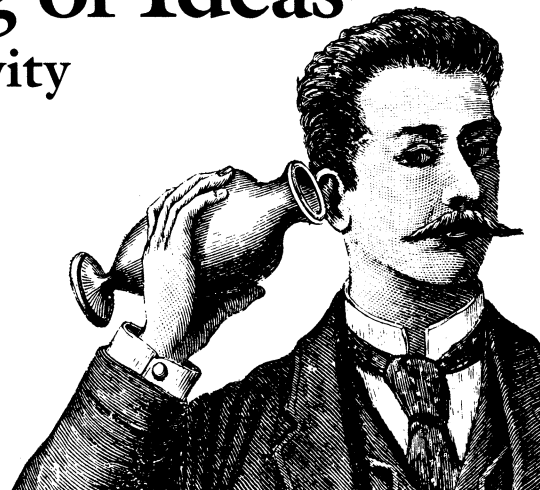
The Care & Feeding of Ideas

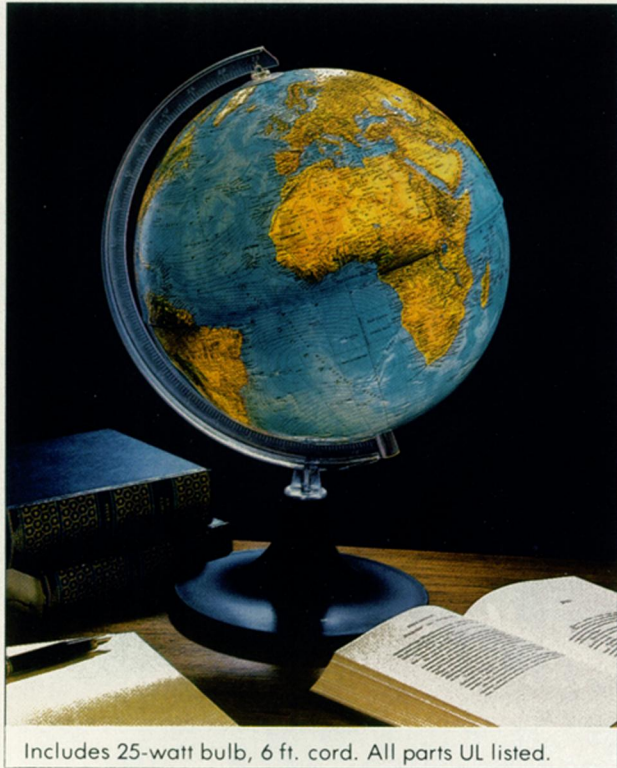
