Here are over 160 word games — instructional and entertaining — that can be played with a friend, in groups of two or more, at a party, by children or simply by yourself. And all you need is a sharp mind and (sometimes) a sharp pencil. This collection of word games contains not only all the classics — the old family favorites such as Botticelli, Jotto and Hangman — but also some interesting surprises, such as Convergence, Double Jeopardy, Arena, Kolodny's Game and Balderdash. The first section of the book is *spoken games* and the second is *written games*. There is also a third section, devoted to *word play*, that embraces the whole range of verbal and linguistic entertainments from anagrams and antigrams to puns and palindromes, via Spoonerisms, Malapropisms and Goldwynisms.

OVERCOMING DEPRESSION

Demitri F. Papolos and Janice Papolos

The book dispels the myths and mysteries surrounding mood disorders. It explains the signs and symptoms of these illnesses, and includes vivid personal accounts by those who suffer these illnesses so the reader can learn more about depressive and manic episodes firsthand. The authors explore the latest theories of causes of mood disorders and explain all facets of the new treatment approaches. Lithium and newer antimanic medications, antidepressants and electroconvulsive therapy are thoroughly described, and the importance of family education and an adjunctive psychotherapy is emphasized.

One section of the book deals with learning to live with the illness: what to do about emergency intervention, hospitalization and commitment procedures; what to expect about costs and insurance coverage; how to explain the illness to family and friends; and whether or not to tell an employer. Listings of support groups and recommendations on how to start and publicize a manic-depressive support group follow the body of the text.

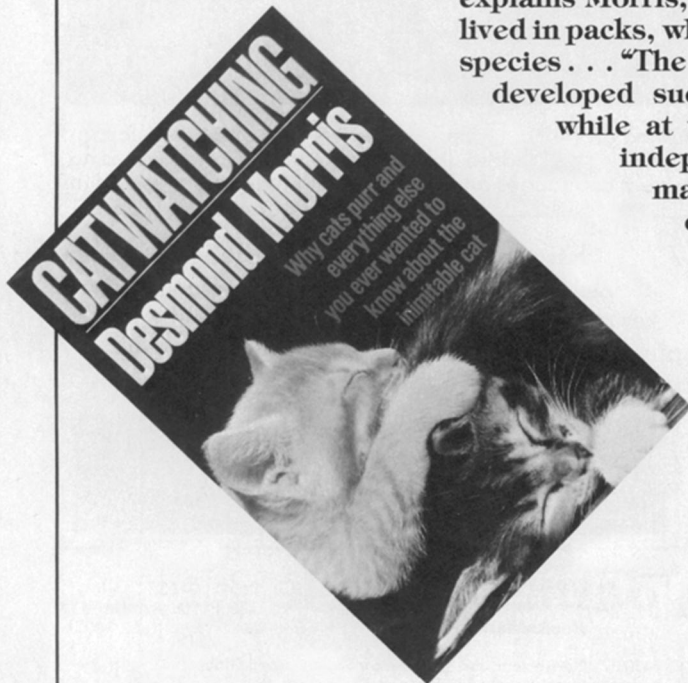

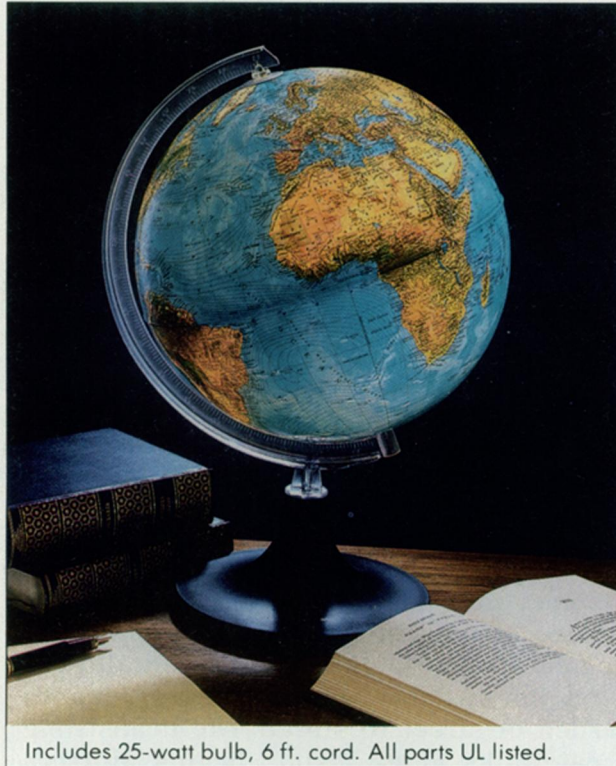
