he Harper Atlas of the Bible sets the Bible in its full context and conveys an almost tangible sense of the land, events and the people portrayed in the world's most famous book. 
The 134 maps together with the specially commissioned full-color artwork convey the sense of the landscape in

The text describes in detail ancient scripts, crafts, industries, equipment of war, and much more.

There is an extensive chronology, a glossary summarizing biographical details of all the biblical personalities involved and an exhaustive placename index that gives not only biblical and extra-biblical names with their equivalents in other languages but also their exact location on the Palestine grid.
