The essence of chaos is a style of thinking about the world that requires no scientific background to understand. Chaos is a science of the everyday world, treating phenomena on a human scale and addressing the questions that every child has wondered about — the formation of clouds, the patterns of sand in the desert, why all snowflakes are different, how smoke rises and how a faucet drips. The first science to sweep across disciplines from ecology and economics to meteorology and physiology, it is a field whose essence is mathematical (with the computer as an essential tool), but whose unfolding affects everyone's lives — the way business executives make decisions about insurance, political analysts talk about stresses leading to armed conflict, the way ordinary people look at the whorls and eddies of a natural stream. Barely a decade old, chaos is being identified by some scientists as the third revolution in the physical sciences in the twentieth century, after relativity and quantum mechanics.

Lewin maintains that in paleoanthropology, more than in other sciences, subjectivity plays a major role. The reason is that because there are so few significant fossils, the interpretations of the fossils takes on greater importance. And interpretation is necessarily open to cultural bias and other prejudices. *BONES OF CONTENTION* is a historical tour of these major controversies in which shifting interpretations of the nature of evolution and of early man have battled for scientific credibility. To a great extent the scientists who have held these views speak for themselves in Lewin's book. 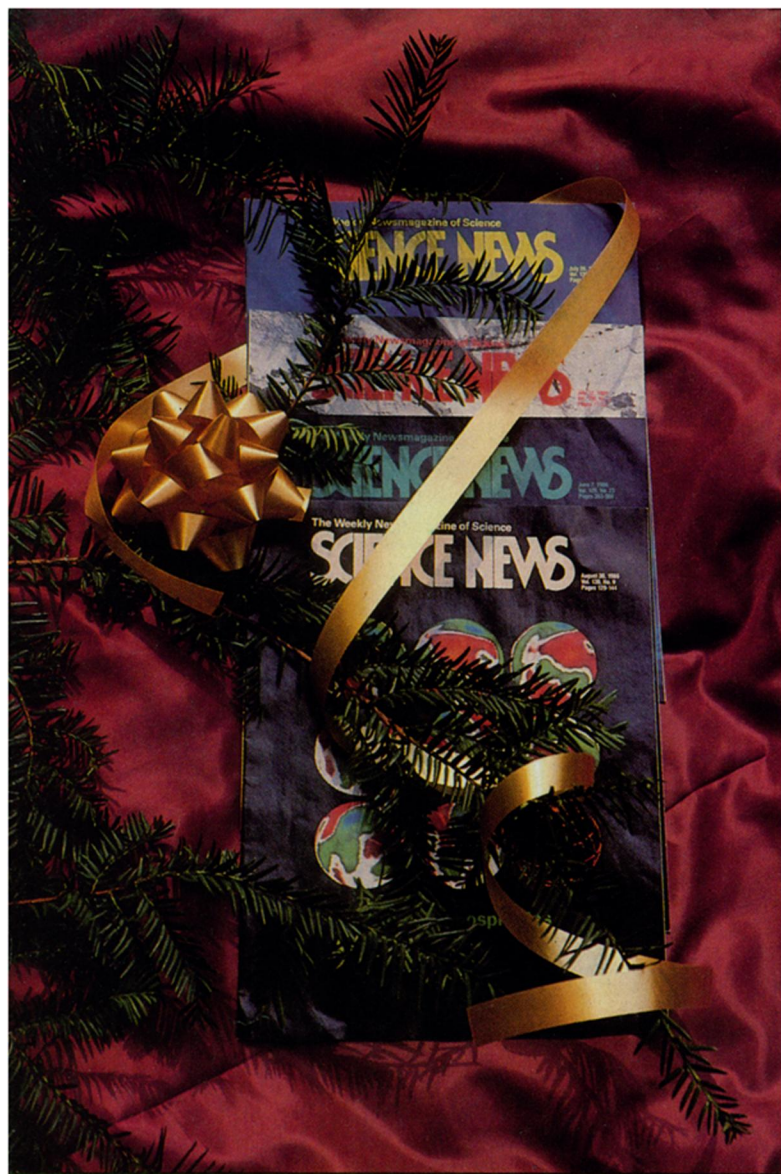
