Using as a primary source his own diaries and records, Seaborg provides an insider's account of the efforts made during the presidency of Lyndon B. Johnson to bring nuclear arms under international control. In an age of nuclear diplomacy, when so much hinges on what is said behind closed doors in Washington or Geneva or Reykjavik, outsiders can only wonder who is taking what position, and what words and what arguments are used. 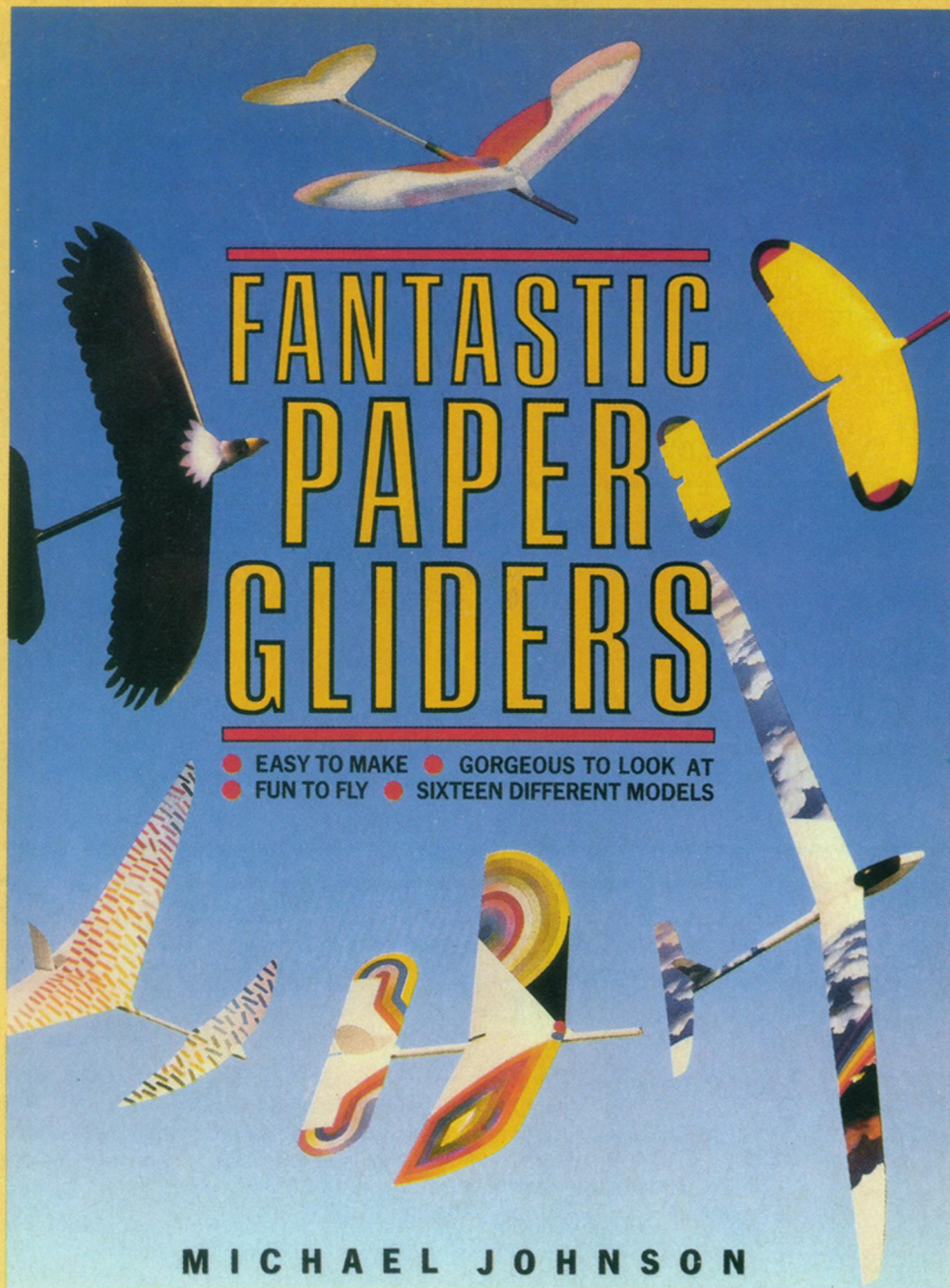
