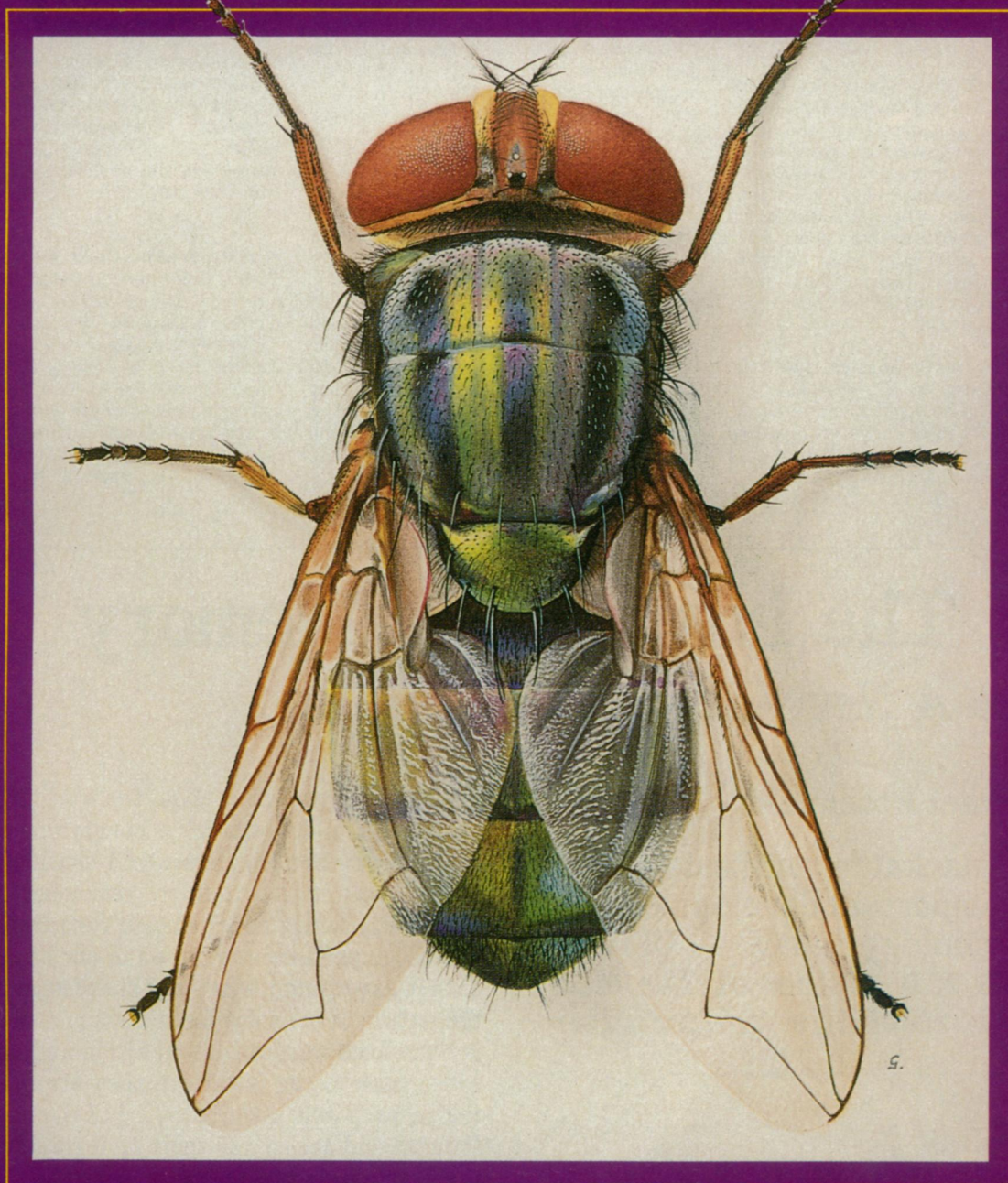

Nazca and the Mysteries of Peru

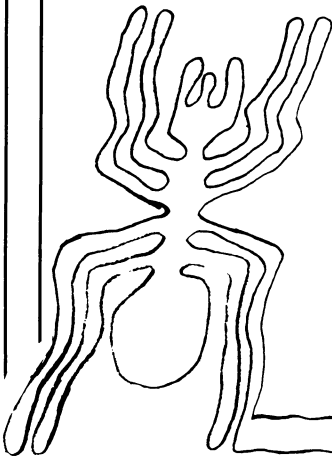

Lines to the Mountain Gods takes the reader on a journey through the history and lives of the Nazcan people and the mysteries of Peru. It focuses on the desert-like expanse of red-brown pebbles known as the Nazca "pampa." This stony desert is filled with enigmatic lines and figures that have remained virtually unchanged for centuries. Hadingham attempts to answer the many questions surrounding these markings and suggests reasons why they can be fully appreciated only when viewed from the air.
