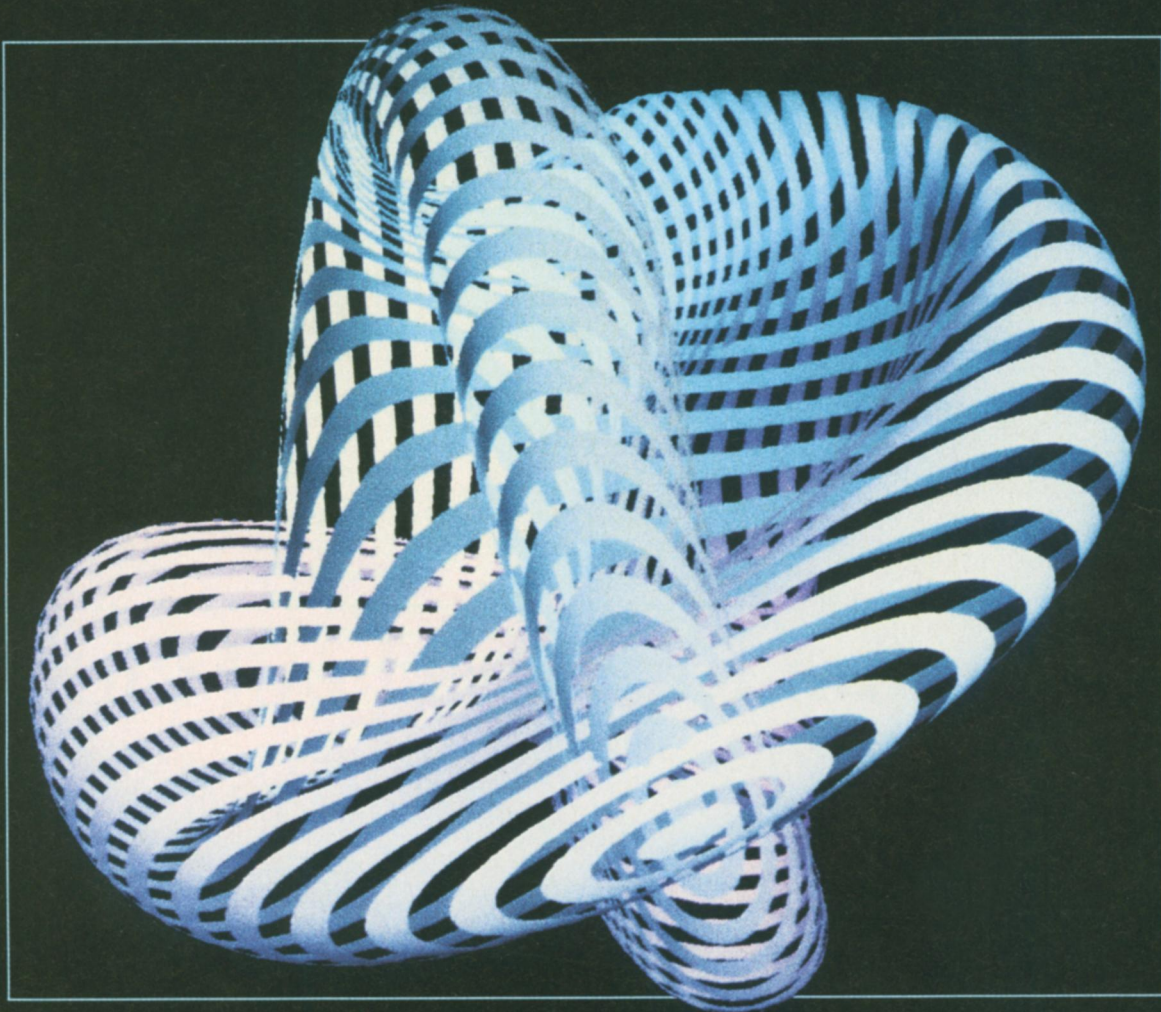

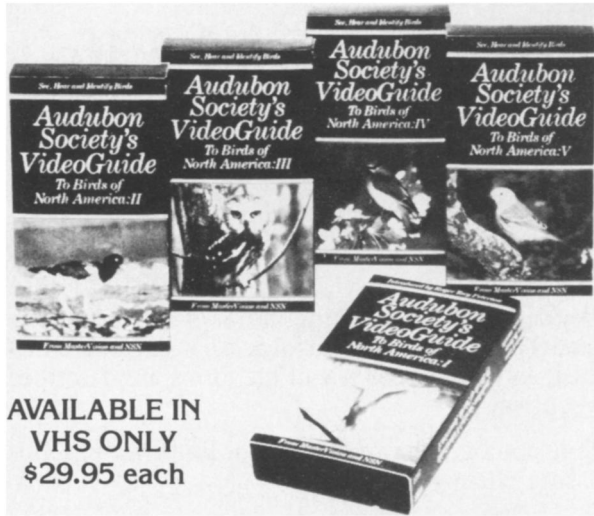

The Audubon Society's Video Guides to the Birds of North America contain film and video footage, still photographs, computer-animated range maps and bird calls and sounds from the Cornell Ornithological Laboratory for more than 450 species. Each new volume runs approximately one hour and features video footage of more than 80 percent of the included species, augmented by still photographs taken by master nature photographers.

**Volume 1** covers 116 species of loons, grebes, pelicans and their allies, swans, geese and ducks, hawks, vultures and falcons.

**Volume 2** covers 112 species of water birds, including herons, egrets and cranes.

**Volume 3** covers 70 species of pigeons and doves, cuckoos, owls, nighthawks and hummingbirds.

**Volumes 4 and 5** contain moving and still footage and the calls and sounds of swallows, crows, chickadees, nuthatches, wrens and thrushes.
