Turbulent Mirror explores the many faces of chaos and reveals how its laws direct most of the familiar processes of everyday life, from our heartbeat and thoughts to the formation of clouds and storms, from the composition of a poem to the spread of a forest fire or the path taken by a winding coastline. Briggs and Peat also demonstrate how chaos theory has encouraged a rethinking of some of the fundamental principles of scientific investigation. The now-famous chaos aphorism that the flutter of a butterfly's wing in Hong Kong can change the weather in New York is a dramatic illustration of what Briggs and Peat describe as an "emerging science of wholeness," a growing scientific appreciation of how everything in the universe is interconnected.

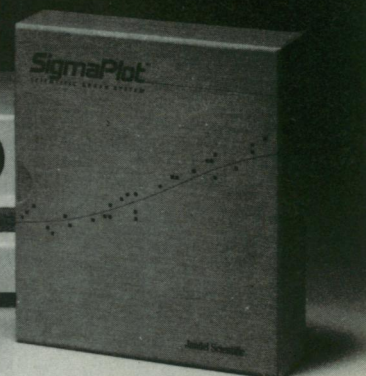
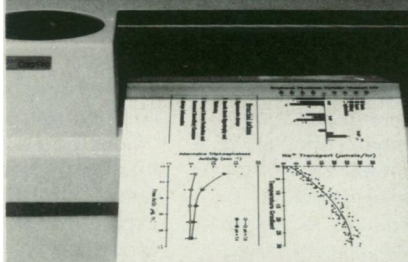
