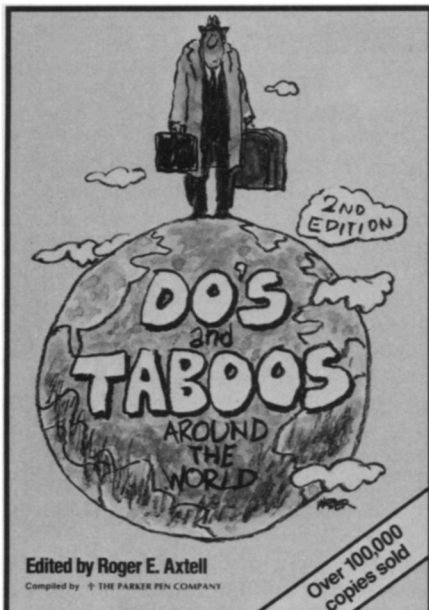

Legacy of the CAT

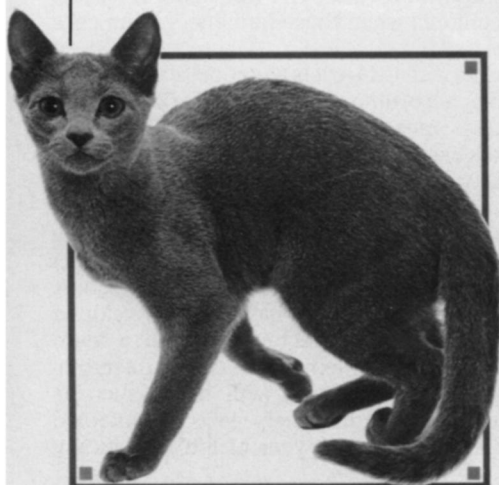
