Organized into four principal sections, the encyclopedia revolutionizes information retrieval by presenting knowledge in the way the mind normally receives it, by linking and associating ideas, facts, concepts and visual images. The first section, the colorpedia, is a series of full-color, two-page articles, each on a single subject and each related thematically to the articles that precede and follow it. This extraordinary reference book is rounded out with a time chart of important events in human culture from 4000 B.C. to 1990 A.D. and a full-color Rand McNally Atlas of the World. The concluding section is an extensive bibliography of 1,500 citations arranged according to the themes of the colorpedia. This unique organization makes the encyclopedia a browser's dream as well as a valuable learning tool.
