The Hundredth Monkey: And Other Paradigms of the Paranormal - Kendrick Frazier, Ed. The Commitee for the Scientific Investigation of Claims of the Paranormal (CSICOP) was established in 1976 to provide accurate, scientific information about bizarre paranormal claims and to encourage the public to use reason and critical thinking to separate fact from tabloid fiction. This collection of 43 articles written by noted researchers and scholars investigates and establishes scientifically feasible explanations for various fringe-science claims such as the alienabduction experience and spontaneous humancombusition deaths. His spectacular collection of photos and his brief, personal reflections capture the mystery and magnificence of humankind's possible birthplace. Wild India: The Wildlife and Scenery of India and Nepal—Gerald Cubitt and Guy Mountfort. An exquisite photographic celebration of the natural history of the Indian subcontinent. Mountfort's text briefly describes the area's natural resources as well as the pressures imposed by development and population growth, and is followed by more than 400 color photographs and detailed captions that capture the splendor of the natural environment.
