

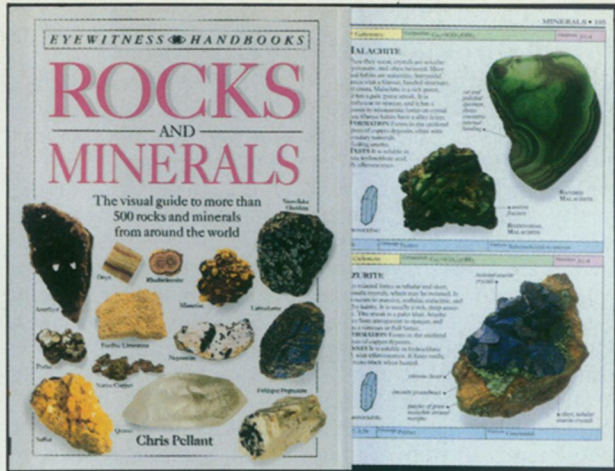
More than 500 specimens and 600 photos are featured in each book!
